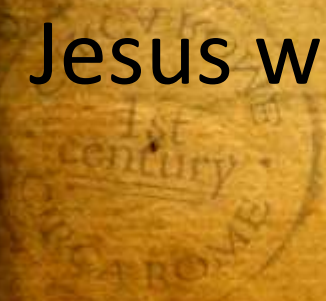

1 This is a **faithful saying**: If a man desires the position of a bishop, he desires a good work.





1 Timothy 4:7–9 (NKJV)

7 But reject profane and old wives' fables, and exercise yourself toward godliness.

8 For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.

4 But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,
