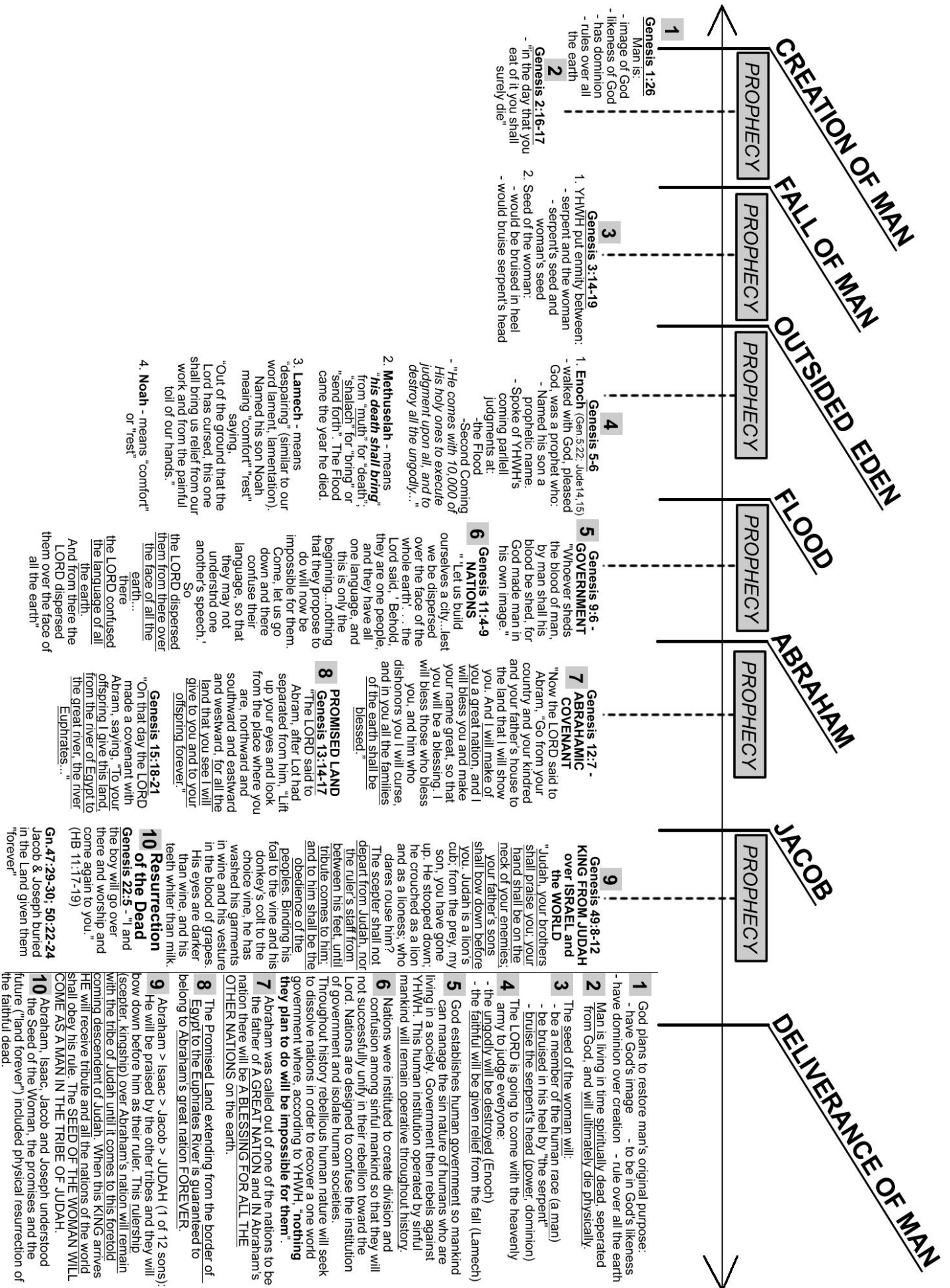


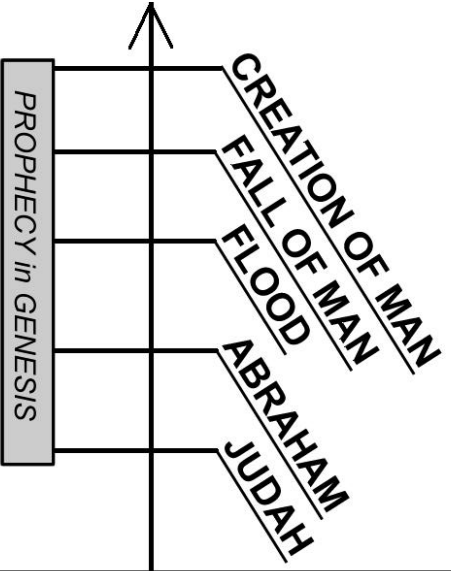
Future Eschatology in Genesis:

1. God plans to restore man's original purpose:
 - a. Have God's image
 - b. To be in God's likeness
 - c. Have dominion over creation
 - d. Rule over all the earth
2. Man is living in time spiritually dead, separated from God, and will ultimately die physically.
3. The seed of the woman will:
 - a. Be a member of the human race (a man)
 - b. Be bruised in his heel (physical set back) by "the serpent"
 - c. Bruise the serpent's head (power, dominion)
4. The LORD is going to come with the heavenly army to judge everyone:
 - a. The ungodly will be destroyed (Enoch)
 - b. The faithful will be given relief from the fall (Lamech)
5. God establishes human government so mankind can manage the sin nature of humans who are living in a society. Government then rebels against YHWH. This human institution operated by sinful mankind will remain operative throughout history.
6. Nations were instituted to create division and confusion among sinful mankind so that they will not successfully unify in their rebellion toward the Lord. Nations are designed to confuse the institution of government and isolate human societies. Throughout history rebellious human nature will seek to dissolve nations in order to recover a one world government where, according to YHWH, "nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them."
7. Abraham was called out of one of the nations to be the father of A GREAT NATION and IN Abraham's nation there will be A BLESSING FOR ALL THE OTHER NATIONS on the earth.
8. The Promised Land extending from the border of Egypt to the Euphrates River is guaranteed to belong to Abraham's great nation FOREVER.
9. Abraham → Isaac → Jacob → JUDAH (1 of 12 sons): His brothers will bow down before him and praise him as their ruler. This rulership (scepter, kingship) over Abraham's nation will remain with the tribe of Judah until it comes to this foretold coming descendent of Judah. When this KING arrives HE will receive tribute and all the nations of the world shall obey his rule.
10. Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Joseph understood the Seed of the Woman, the promises and the future ("land forever") included physical resurrection of the faithful dead.
 - a. Also consider from the same time period as Abraham the man Job who says in Job 19:25-27,
"For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last he will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God, whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another. My heart faints within me!"

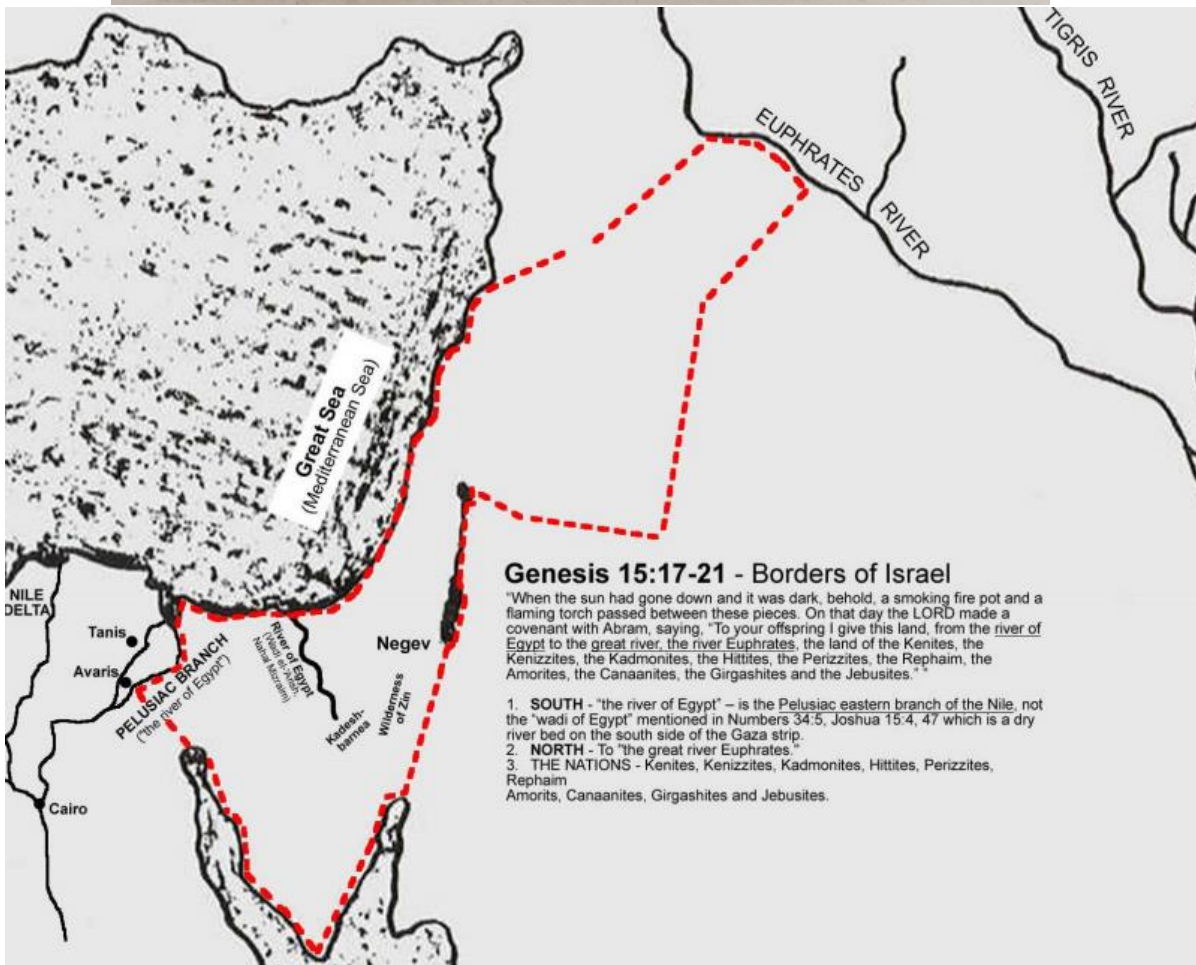
Rebellion vs YHWH

The Conflict, bruises the King from Judah, but the King from Judah bruises the source of the power of all rebellion vs YHWH

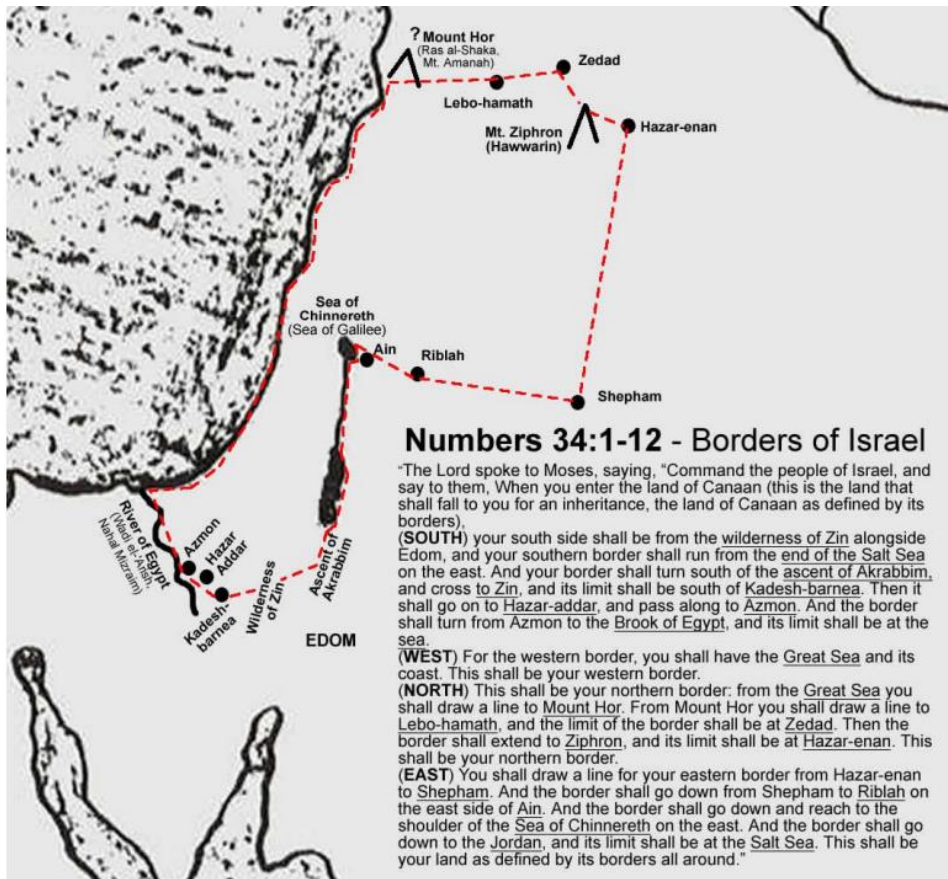
1. The Seed of the Woman:
 - (a man) will be born who will destroy the power of the serpent,
 - he will suffer a physical set back in the process.
2. There will be governments and nations. These will continue in rebellion to the Lord.
3. Abraham's nation will be formed to bless the rebellious nations, not to destroy them. The Lord is going to use Abraham's nation to help restore mankind.
4. Abraham's nation will be given a land that will be theirs forever.
5. The Seed of the Woman will be:
 a) a descendent of Abraham
 b) a descendent from the tribe of Judah

Numbers 34:1-12 - Borders of Israel

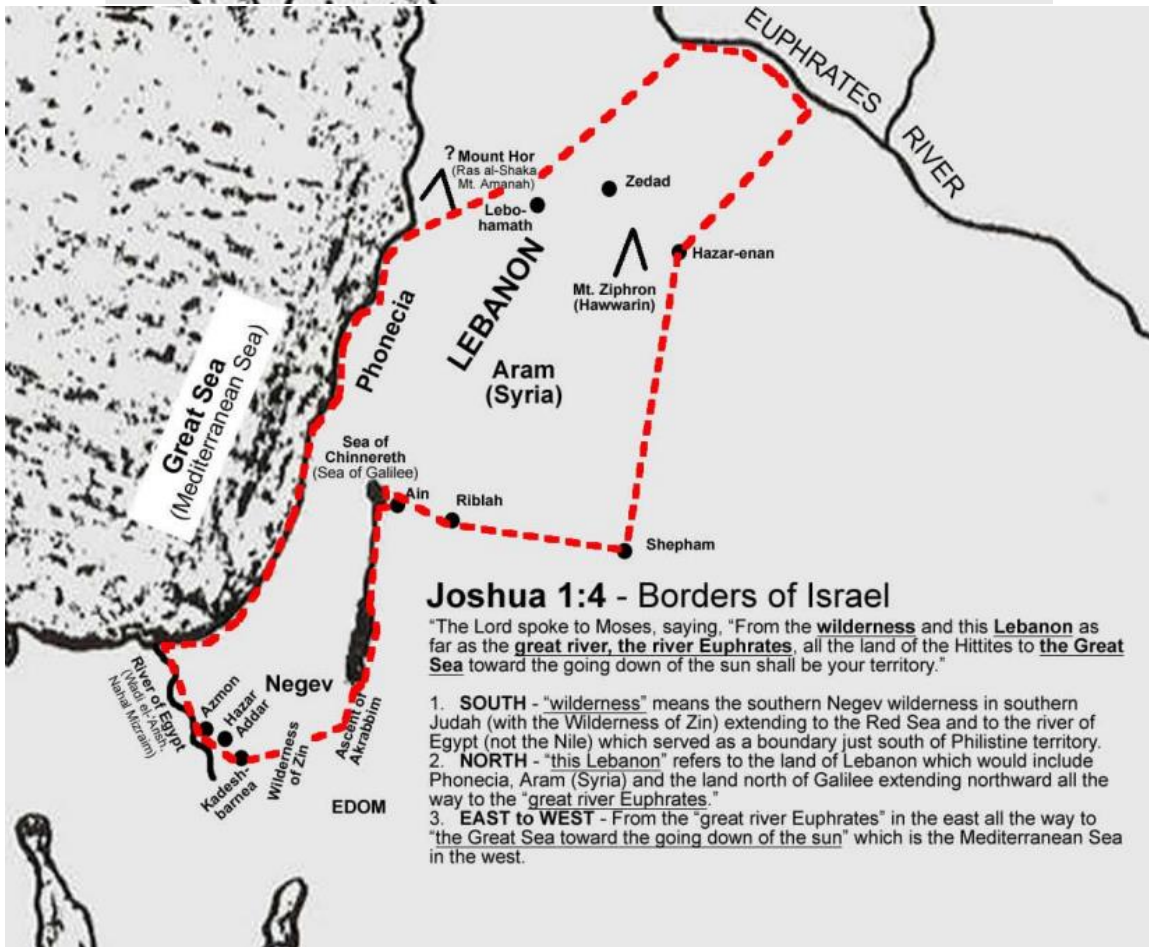
"The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Command the people of Israel, and say to them, When you enter the land of Canaan (this is the land that shall fall to you for an inheritance, the land of Canaan as defined by its borders),

(SOUTH) your south side shall be from the wilderness of Zin alongside Edom, and your southern border shall run from the end of the Salt Sea on the east. And your border shall turn south of the ascent of Akrabim, and cross to Zin, and its limit shall be south of Kadesh-barnea. Then it shall go on to Hazar-addar, and pass along to Azmon. And the border shall turn from Azmon to the Brook of Egypt, and its limit shall be at the sea.

(WEST) For the western border, you shall have the Great Sea and its coast. This shall be your western border.

(NORTH) This shall be your northern border: from the Great Sea you shall draw a line to Mount Hor. From Mount Hor you shall draw a line to Lebo-hamath, and the limit of the border shall be at Zedad. Then the border shall extend to Ziphron, and its limit shall be at Hazar-enan. This shall be your northern border.

(EAST) You shall draw a line for your eastern border from Hazar-enan to Shepham. And the border shall go down from Shepham to Riblah on the east side of Ain. And the border shall go down and reach to the shoulder of the Sea of Chinnereth on the east. And the border shall go down to the Jordan, and its limit shall be at the Salt Sea. This shall be your land as defined by its borders all around."



Joshua 1:4 - Borders of Israel

"The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun shall be your territory."

1. **SOUTH** - "wilderness" means the southern Negev wilderness in southern Judah (with the Wilderness of Zin) extending to the Red Sea and to the river of Egypt (not the Nile) which served as a boundary just south of Philistine territory.
2. **NORTH** - "this Lebanon" refers to the land of Lebanon which would include Phoenicia, Aram (Syria) and the land north of Galilee extending northward all the way to the "great river Euphrates."
3. **EAST to WEST** - From the "great river Euphrates" in the east all the way to "the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun" which is the Mediterranean Sea in the west.
