I. TWO POWERFUL OBJECTS OF LIFE ARE REVEALED

- A. The tree of life Rev 22:2; Eze 47:7, 12
 - 1. In the Garden of Eden
 - 2. After the fall and after the flood
 - 3. The memory of the fallen: trees in mythology
 - 4. Trees as sacred objects and places of worship
 - 5. The trees (of life) in Ezekiel, on earth
 - 6. The tree of life in Revelation, in the holy city
 - 7. The tree as an illustration of a successful godly person
- B. The river of life or the river giving life
 - 1. In the Garden
 - 2. After the flood: Eden is gone; topography changed; old names given to new rivers that are the drainage system for the mountains and fountains
 - 3. Water is life
 - 4. Waters during the tribulation: poisoned, polluted, bloodied
 - 5. The value of water; water thieves; importance
 - 6. The river of life in the city Rev 22:1-2
 - 7. The river of life on earth Eze 47:1-12
 - 8. Jesus as the provider of the Water of Life Jn 7:37; Jn 4:7-14; 1 Cor 10:
 - 9. The Holy Spirit as the rivers of living water that would flow from every believer Jn 7:38-39

II. WATER FOR REFRESHMENT, FRUIT AND LEAVES

- A. The river in the heavenly city
 - 1. Proceeds from the throne of God and of the Lamb
 - 2. It is life-giving
 - 3. Clear as crystal; more like a fountain; it has no final destination
- B. The tree of life in the heavenly city
 - 1. A forest of life-giving trees
 - 2. Yields fruit every month; twelve fruits
 - 3. Leaves are for healing
- C. The river in the earthly Jerusalem Eze 47:1-12
 - 1. Proceeds out of the temple of earthly Jerusalem
 - 2. It gets deeper and deeper as it proceeds south east
 - 3. It flows to the Dead Sea and brings it to life
 - 4. It brings life to all living things near it, except...
 - 5. Full of fish and fishermen prosper from it
- D. The tree(s) in the earthly Jerusalem
 - 1. Forest of trees on either side of the river
 - 2. The trees bear fruit every month
 - 3. The fruit is for food and the leaves for healing
- E. The Presence of the Lord in the City
 - 1. His servants shall serve Him
 - 2. They shall see His face; interactive, responsive, not virtual
 - 3. His name will be in their foreheads
 - 4. The Throne of God and the Lamb shall be in it
 - 5. No night there for the Lord God gives them light
 - 6. They shall reign forever and ever
