smite 'the judge of Israel' upon the cheek hist: 2 Kings 25:6

doct: Mark 15:19

v 2 Bethlehem ('house of bread') - a male descendant of Caleb

Ephratah ('fertility') - the grandmother of Caleb, (Numbers 13:6 & 30)

his goings forth ... from everlasting [pv - antiquity, ancient times, distant past] Psalm 90:1-2

Jesus is the only man in history who had his place of birth named before he was born.

God used His prophets also, to tell - 1 Peter 1:9-11

- the tribe of his birth Genesis 49:10
- the family of his birth 2 Samuel 7:8, 12 & 13
- the manner of his birth Isaiah 7:14
 - the time of his birth Daniel 9:24-25

There are 48 prophecies on the first coming of Christ in the O.T.

- v3 the remnant = Romans 11:25-26
- v 4 now shall he be great ~ Luke 4:37 & 5:15
- v 5 this man = **John 19:5** 1 **Timothy 2:3-6** & **3:16**
- v 7 Israel supreme Numbers 23:22-24, Deuteronomy 28:1 & 10
- v 8 **Proverbs 28:1**
- v 15 Divine Vengeance Isaiah 66:6, 15-16; Habakkuk 3:12; Malachi 4:1-3

Summary: Christ came (v 2-3), Christ saw (v 1, 5-6), Christ conquered (v 7-15)

This is an example of a "cataphoric" pronoun, i.e. "forward looking".

v 2 <u>English Lesson</u> pronoun = he; noun = the ruler in Israel

e.g. "After his discovery of New Zealand, Captain Cook went on to discover several Pacific Islands."
