



“Evangelism”

*Being a Witness
Exodus 18:1-12*

A good witness will:

I. Relate - “Moses’ father in law” (vs. 1-7)

Our Gospel :

- A. Remembers** – “Jethro, the priest of Midian”
- B. Receives** – “Moses went out to meet his father in law”
- C. Respects** – “did obeisance, and kissed him, and asked”

II. Recite - “And Moses told his father in law all” (vs. 8-9)

Our God:

- A. Defends** - “had done unto Pharaoh...for Israel’s sake”
- B. Directs** – “the travail that had come on them by the way”
- C. Delivers** – “how the Lord had delivered them”

III. Rejoice - “Jethro rejoiced for all the goodness” (vs. 9-12)

Our God is:

- A. Sympathetic** – “all the goodness which the Lord had done”
- B. Superior** - “the Lord is greater than all gods ”
- C. Sovereign** - “wherein they dealt proudly He was above them”

Sentence Sermon:

*“Evangelism is simply glorifying God,
loving the Lost and giving out the Gospel.”*
