I. Focus on working out your salvation II. Focus on reflecting your new nature III. Focus on bearing testimony in walk and talk

**I.** GOD'S DIRECTION IS TO FOCUS ON *WORKING OUT YOUR OWN SALVATION* A. The motivation for His direction: *therefore* 

B. The content of His direction: work out your own salvation

- 1. This sounds contradictory to Phil. 1:6; 2:13; Eph. 2:10
- 2. Meaning of work out your own salvation
- 3. How are we to work out this salvation we now possess?
- C. The seriousness of His direction: with fear and trembling 1. This verse does not contradict 1 John 4:18
  - 2. Phil. 2:12 is like 1 Peter 1:17 ... pass your sojourning here in fear
  - 3. One day every saint will stand face the judgment seat of Christ a. see 2 Cor. 5:9-11; 1 Cor. 3:10-15
- D. The enabling for this direction: vs. 13

## **II. FOCUS ON REFLECTING THIS NEW NATURE**

A. What are the details of this *working out our own salvation*?
1. to do all things without murmuring & disputings (vs. 14)
a. what things?

b. how are we do this?

- 2. to be blameless and harmless, without rebuke a. what is blameless?
  - b. what is harmless?
  - c. what is without rebuke?
- B. Where are we to reflect this Christian character? 1. First of all towards *fellow believers* (vs. 1-4)
  - 2. Secondly in *midst of crooked and perverse nation* (vs. 15)
- III. FOCUS ON BEARING TESTIMONY IN WALK AND TALK
- A. Our calling as 'saints of God' is a high calling: to be holy as the LORD is holy1. That's not the testimony that our crooked/perverse nation welcomes
  - 2. "Among whom ye shine as lights in the world"a. image is taken from a lighthouse on seacoasts
    - b. how vividly this depicts our position & task as Christians
    - c. yet we not just to be like silent lighthouse
  - 3. How do we shine: Holding forth the word of life

Take along: *The call is not to withdraw but to allure!* A. Christ does not expect us to change our culture

- B. Christ calls His saints to stand shoulder to shoulder in the battle (vs. 2)1. Remember the *front-line soldiers in midst of the dark world* 
  - 2. Remember those in *leadership positions*
  - 3. Remember those *living in continued rebellion or fear*
