**“FOR THOU ONLY ART HOLY” (REV. 15:4)**

The call: *Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at His footstool: for He is holy*

**I. What is to worship Him at His footstool?**

A. To worship is an *experiential response* of our whole heart to God’s glory

**B. What are the various experiential responses fitting before His footstool?**

A. To worship is to *stand in awe – adore – filled with reverence*

1. Ps. 33:8 *Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.*

2. Is. 66:1-2 *Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool (...) but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.*

B. To worship is to *be still and know that I am God who does no wrong!*

1. Job 1:20-21 *Then Job arose (...) and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped, and said, (...) the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD (Job 40:4-5!)*

C. To worship is to *trust Him* as you journey through life’s difficulties

1. Is. 40:1, 9 *Comfort ye, comfort ye my people (...) lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God! (Is. 40:1-17; 18; 21-26)*

2. Job 23:8-10 *Behold, I go forward, but he is not there; and backward, but I cannot perceive him; on the left hand, where he doth work, but I cannot behold him; he hideth himself on the right hand, that I cannot see Him: but He knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.*

D. To worship Him in beauty of holiness is *to walk in holiness*

1. 1 Peter 1:15-16, *But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.* (Heb 12:14)
2. 1 Peter 1:22 *Seeing ye have purified [holiness] your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure [holy] heart fervently.*

a. What was (is) holiness in Jesus? (Matt. 5:17 compared to 12:1-14)

b. What does He require when calling disciples to be holy? (Matt. 5:48)

c. Such holiness is utterly beyond our reach (indwelling sin)

John 15:4 *Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me.*

**Is your question:** *How can I change, live more holy, be what He calls me to be?*
