What Must I Do to be Saved?

1) Not Personal Achievement – v. 5

2) By the Word of Faith – v. 6-13

a) The Apostle's Gospel

1. Not attained by law-keeping – v. 5
2. Christ born, died, raised, exalted as Lord – v. 6-13
3. Response – Believe & Confess / Call on – v. 9-13

b) Right Response

1. Believe with the Heart
 - Trust
 - Full Person
2. Confess with the Mouth
 - Why Necessary?
 - Jesus as Lord
 - Call on Name of the Lord

c) God's Response

1. Saved – v. 9,10,13
2. Justified – v. 10
3. Not put to shame – v. 11
4. Bestowed riches – v. 12

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3) Which is Equally Accessible

- a) All inclusive – v. 9-13

- b) Jew / Gentile – no distinction – v. 12

KSN [heart, mouth / vow, rich, play]

Praxis

1. In Gospel Sharing, is it important to know whether you are speaking to a “Jew-type” person or “Greek-type” person? Why / Why not?
2. What if you have confessed with your mouth... how can you know if you truly believe in your heart?
3. Col 2:6 would say we should believe / confess / call on every day... What does that look like? What would it look like if not doing so?
4. Thought Question: Why does God require spiritual actions to be done in a physical way (like confessing with mouth, baptism, Lord’s supper, gathering for fellowship, singing together, etc)?
