Proverbs 8:22-31 — "Marvel at God's Wisdom Revealed in Creation!"

Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you thinks that he is wise in this age, he must become foolish, so that he may become wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness before God. For it is written, "He is THE ONE WHO CATCHES THE WISE IN THEIR CRAFTINESS"; and again, "THE LORD KNOWS THE REASONINGS of the wise, THAT THEY ARE USELESS." (1 Corinthians 3:18-20)

Thomas Watson said the wisdom of God is "one of the brightest beams of the Godhead!"

- We see God's wisdom in his (1) perfect intelligence and his (2) meticulous working. In God's meticulous works we see **3 primary demonstrations** of wisdom:
 - Redemption (Rom 11.33-36)
 - Providence (Eph 1.11; Ps 119:91)
 - Creation (here in Prov 8; Job 38-42; Psalm 104)

THESIS — Proverbs 8 thunders the wisdom of God in Creation! Come! Behold! Watch! Marvel! Stand in Awe!

1. Wisdom's Antiquity BEFORE CREATION

- 2. Wisdom's **Activity** IN CREATION
- 3. Wisdom's Felicity IN CREATION (joy)

I. WISDOM'S **ANTIQUITY** BEFORE CREATION (22-26)

- Note all the *temporal* phrases; wisdom has been around for a very long time!
 - Wisdom is EXTERNAL to us. >> it's not inside us, within us, innate to us.
 - Wisdom is JOYOUS over us. It's not a nag; >> Joy comes from wisdom!
 - Wisdom is AVAILABLE to us. We are to pray & God will give (James 1.5)

II. WISDOM'S **ACTIVITY** IN CREATION (27-29)

- A. Review of God's active & sole & sovereign work From Genesis 1:
 - Day 1 Light (Gen 1.3-5)
 - Day 2 Waters, heavens (Gen 1.6-8)
 - Day 3 dry land, vegetation (Gen 1.9-13)
 - Day 4 sun and moon and stars (Gen 1.14-19)
 - Day 5 Great creatures of the sea & the air (Gen 1.20-23)
 - Day 6 climactic day: mankind (Gen 1.24-31)
 - Day 7 God rested (Gen 2.1-3)

Here in Proverbs 8, we see this pattern as well:

- 1. Prov 8:27a- wisdom was there when God set the heavens in place (Gen 1.1-5)
- 2. Prov 8:28- separated the waters making clouds and oceans on Day #2 (Gen 1.6-8)
- 3. Prov 8:29- and when he caused the dry land to appear (Day #3 Gen 1.9-10)
- God's creation of the physical world becomes a picture of his new-creation of spiritual life (2 Cor 4.6).

Gal. 6:15 For neither is circumcision anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

III. WISDOM'S *FELICITY* IN CREATION (30-31)

v.30 - his "delight" [word for delight in Hebrew is *plural*]; like saying: I was **multiple** delights day-to-day.

See the progression: rejoicing in GOD's PRESENCE, in GOD's EARTH, and in GOD's PEOPLE.

Interestingly: in v.30, 2x we see "I AM" (NASB: "I was") - same hebrew verb as Ex 3.14 - where God reveals himself as Yahweh, I AM. This wisdom speaks *in the same phrase*.

The God of Wisdom // Applications // Implementation ...

- 1. God **Delights** in Wisdom. So should you and I delight in wisdom.
- 2. God manifested his supreme wisdom in **creation**. Let us marvel at God's wisdom.
- 3. God **rejoices** in His Creation. So should you & I marvel at and rejoice in God in HIs fingerprints.
- 4. God owns and **possesses** the earth. So should we remember God rules sovereignly over all circumstances and events on earth.
- 5. God's wisdom **stands the test of time**. So should we stand on God's revealed wisdom rather than this world
- 6. God's supreme **uniqueness** shines forth in His creation. So should we bow before God alone & worship Him only.
- 7. God's wisdom in **creation** reminds us of His wisdom in **the new-creation**. Bless & praise God for giving life to you when you had none.
- 8. God manifests **such care** for all his creatures and his creation (in all galaxies from large to small). So let us entrust our daily care, provisions, love and confidence in HIM knowing that He will freely give us all things in Christ.

In 1820 A.D. a man named Hubert Spencer gave the world five scientific principles by which man may study the unknown. They are time, force, energy, space, and matter. However, Moses, by inspiration, gave us those scientific principles in Genesis 1:1.

- "In the beginning" --time;
- "God"-- force;
- "created" -- energy;
- "the heavens" --space;
- "and the earth" -- matter.

All of Spencer's scientific principles are right there in Genesis 1:1.

- 1. TO GLORIFY HIMSELF (PS 19.1)
- 2. TO DEMONSTRATE HIS LOVE (PS 136)
- 3. TO REJOICE IN HIS WORKS (PS 104:31)
- 4. TO SHOW HIS ATTRIBUTES (ROM 1.20)
- 5. TO POINT TO REGENERATION: GOD'S RE-CREATION (2 COR 4.6)
- 6. TO CALL ALL TO WORSHIP HIM (REV 4.11)
