Genesis 22:1-19 -- The Angel of Jehovah (6)

Introduction

"Jehovah-jireh"

- I. Proving Abraham's faith
 - A. The difficult test
 - 1. Very literal -- kill your son; not a temptation, but a test or trial
 - 2. The test was difficult because Isaac was so dear to him (v. 2)
 - a. He was the son of promise
 - b. He was a wonder child
 - c. He was the child of Abraham and Sarah's old age
 - B. Abraham's Faith and Obedience
 - 1. Abraham responds in obedience, immediately, without hesitation or argument.
 - 2. But, there's a process, a period of reasoning that finally reaches these conclusions.
 - a. V. 5, we (I and the lad) will return
 - b. V. 8, God will provide a lamb
 - c. Hebrews 11, God will raise Isaac from the dead
 - C. What was the secret to the strength of Abraham's faith?
 - 1. His closeness to God -- "the friend of God"
 - 2. His eye was on Christ
 - D. The Angel of Jehovah is the one trying Abraham
- II. Providing a Lamb for Sacrifice
 - A. When Abraham is ready to kill, the Angel of Jehovah spares Isaac and provides a lamb
 - B. This is the central event in the chapter -- Jehovah will provide a Lamb, a substitute for sinners
 - C. The Angel of Jehovah is the one making this provision
- III. Promising Great Things in Isaac
 - A. The elements of the promise
 - 1. I will multiply thee exceedingly
 - 2. Thy seed shall possess the gates of his enemy
 - 3. In thee shall all the nations of the earth be blessed
 - B. The assurance in the promise
 - 1. God swears by himself -- to confirm the faith of His people
 - 2. The way of assurance
 - a. Obedience
 - b. Believing the promises of God
