 - b) With Authority v. 16
 - With a shout of command
 - With voice of Archangel
 - With trumpet of God
 - c) Dead in Christ will rise first v. 16

d) Living in Christ will be Raptured – v. 17

(harpadzo / raptura) – meaning to seize or snatch away with force

e) Into the Clouds to Meet the Lord in the Air – v. 17
