# "Changed!" Colossians 3:8-11

### **Introduction:**

- 1. Please Go Back With Me In Your Bibles This Morning:
  - To Colossians 3 Where Last Sunday:
    - God Used The Apostle Paul:
      - To Address With Some Of The Major:
        - Temptations & Sins That We Still, As Christians, Need To "Mortify" And "Put To Death" In Our Lives!
  - Well In The Last Verse We Looked At:
    - Last Week 3:7 Paul Reminds Us That:
      - Those Sins & Those Desires:
        - Are In Our Past!
          - **IE:** They Are In Our Rear-View Mirror!
    - "In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them!"
      - Those Sins Which Really Are All Expressions Of Idolatry Reflect The Way You Were:
        - If You Are A Christian!
          - Not The Way You Are!
- 2. But Why? What Happened?
  - Why Is There To Be Such A Difference Between:
    - A Christian & The Rest Of The World?
      - Because You've Changed!
        - And You've *Been* Changed:
          - By The Lord Jesus Christ!
  - And This Change:
    - Is Not Only To Be Reflected:
      - In Your Deepest *Desires*:
        - It Is Also To Be Reflected:
          - In Your Innermost *Disposition*!
            - And This Is What Paul Deals With Next In:

- 3. 3:8-11 Which Says:
  - "But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. / Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; / And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him: / Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all!"
    - If You Are In Christ, This Morning We See From These Verses That
      - There Needs To Continue To Be:
- 1. A Change In Your Practices!
  - And This Ongoing Change Is Found In:
    - 3:8-9a "But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. / Lie not one to another!"
      - Here We Have Another:
  - Command To Change!
    - In 3:5 Christians Are Commanded To:
      - "Mortify" Our "Members Which Are Upon The Earth!"
        - This Means That You Are To:
          - Do Whatever It Takes To Deprive Your Lust From Its Life!
            - Have You Been Doing This This Week?
              - But Here:
    - In 3:8 We Are Commanded To:
      - "Put Off" Other Sins And Practices:
        - That Once Again We Know About:
          - All Too Well!
    - When Paul Commands Us:
      - To "Put Off" He Wants You To Think:
        - In Another Way As You Deal With Your Sins!
          - He Wants You To Think Of Your Sin As An Old Garment:
            - That Is Worn & Torn & Has Outlived Its Usefulness!

- **IE:** Some Of Us Have A Hard Time Letting Go Of Old & Worn Out Things! Perhaps Its Time To Go Through Your Closet & See What I Mean!
  - It Is No Different In Your Spiritual Lives!
    - There Are Still "Works Of Darkness" That Have No Place In The Closet Of Your Soul!
- It Is Time For Them To Be Changed!
  - It Is Time For You To:
    - Take Those Old Rags Off:
      - And Throw Them Away!
        - IE: And Not Just Given Away To A Thrift Store!
  - You Need To "Put Them Off!"
    - And Then Paul Once Again:
      - Gives Us A List & Identifies The:
- Character Of Change!
  - You & I Need To Put Off:
    - "All These Anger, Wrath, Malice, Blasphemy Filthy Communication Out Of Your Mouth And
    - Lie Not One To Another!"
  - Now Is There Any Connection:
    - Between The First List Of Sins & Vices:
      - And This One?
    - The First List:
      - Has To Do With:
        - Your Unclean Desires:
          - And Your Lusts!
    - This Second List:
      - Has More To Do With:
        - Your Unclean Disposition:
          - Your Anger & Wrath!
  - It Seems Like Paul Is Telling Us:
    - That When You Strive To:
      - "Mortify" Those Old Members Of Sin:
        - They Are Not Going To Die Off Without A Fight!
    - In Fact When Your Old Lusts & Desires:
      - Are Starved & Strangled:
        - It Can Lead To Expression Of Frustration & Disappointment & Disgust!
    - And That Frustration:
      - Can Stir Up All Of These:
        - Different Stages Of Anger:
          - From The Inside Out!
  - I Think James Connects These Things For Us Well:
    - In James 4:1-2 "From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? / Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not!"
      - So You Need To Keep:
        - Putting These Off As Well!
- Put Off Your Anger!
  - The First Word In This List:
    - Is The Same Word Translated In 3:6 To Describe The "Wrath Of God!"
      - But The "Wrath" Here Is Not At All Like God's! It Is An Unclean, An Unholy & An Unrigheous Anger!
  - But It Is An Anger:
    - That Lurks In Your Heart!
      - **IE:** Like A Smoldering Fire Its Not Full In Its Flame But Its There Ready To Burst Forth At The First Provocation!
  - Is There This Kind Of Anger:
    - Or Any Kind Of Bitterness:
      - In Your Heart Today?
    - Remember James 1:20 "For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God!"
      - But Also:
- Put Off Your Wrath!

- This Word Describes What Happens:
  - When The Smoldering Fire Of Your Anger:
    - Is Stoked By Something Or Someone:
      - That Goes Against Your Own Desires!
- It Is A Rage That Will:
  - Burn Within:
    - Until It Can't Be Held In:
      - Any Longer!
- Is There Any Kind Of This Wrath:
  - In Your Heart Today?
    - You Also Need To:
- Put Off Your Malice!
  - Malice Is The Outward Expression:
    - Of Your Heart Of Anger & Wrath!
      - If Wrath Is The "Boiling Up" Of Anger:
        - Malice Is The "Boiling Out!"
  - It Will Express Itself:
    - In A Mean Spirit That Lashes Out:
      - On Anyone That Might Cross:
        - Or Disappoint You!
          - Even Or Especially Those Closest To You!
  - Is There This Kind Of Malice:
    - In Your Life Today?
      - You Need To Deal With It & Put It Off:
        - Before It Further Explodes Into These Other Expressions That Deal With Your Tongue! Also:
- Put Off Your Blasphemy!
  - We Often Use This World:
    - Do Describe Taking The Lord's Name In Vain:
      - But In General Terms It Can Be Done Toward Anybody!
  - You Blaspheme Someone:
    - When Rail On Someone When You Lash Out:
      - On Someone In Anger!
  - Its What Happens When You Say Something:
    - That You Often Immediately Regret!
      - Remember How James Describes Your Tongue? James 3:5-6 "Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! / And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell!"
  - Is There This Kind Of Blasphemy:
    - In Your Tongue Today?
      - When It Gets To This Point, Though:
        - You Need To Remember That There Is Much More Behind It:
          - Than You Might Let On!
  - You Need To Deal With:
    - Your Tongue:
      - At The Earlier Stages:
        - Of Anger & Wrath & Malice!
          - Put Them Off! Also:
- Put Off Your Filthy Communication!
  - Any Kind Of Speech That:
    - May Be Crude & Rude!
      - Words That Are Meant To:
        - Sting & Hurt & Abuse:
          - Someone In Your Life!
  - Instead Of Building Others Up:
    - This Kind Of Communication:
      - Tears Them Down!
        - You Can Speak This Way:

- To Someone! Or:
- You Can Speak This Way:
  - About Someone!
- Remember What Jesus Tells Us:
  - In Matthew 5:34-35 "For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. / A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things!"
    - What Is **Your** Heart Like This Morning?
      - You Can Know It By Your Speech! To Others! About Others!
        - But Even Further:

- Put Off Your Lying!
  - In 3:9a Paul Adds Another Command To This List:
    - "Lie Not One To Another!"
- Christian There Need To Continue To Be:
  - This Kind Of Change:
    - In Your Practices!
  - You Are Called To:
    - "Put Off" All Of These Things!
      - From The First Movement Of Your Heart In Anger To The Final Expressions In Your Words!
        - "All These" Sins Do Not Become You As A Christian Any More!
          - They Are The Torn & Worn Garments Of Your Old Flesh!
  - You Need To Change!
    - But We All Know How Difficult This Change:
      - Can Be! And This Is Why Paul Then Tells Us Not Only Why We Need To Change:
        - But *How* We Can Change!
          - You Can Change Because There Has Already Been:
- 2 A Change In Your Person!
  - 3:9b-10a "Seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; / And have put on the new man!"
    - Here Paul Provides The Basis Of Your Change!
      - In Essence He Says:
        - You Need To Keep "Putting Off" Your Sin:
          - Because You Have "Put Off" That Old Man!
    - You Can Change:
      - Because You've Been Changed!
        - You Can Change Your Practices:
          - Because You've Been Changed:
            - In Your Person!
    - Remember The Truth Of 2 Corinthians 5:17:
      - "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new!"
        - You Can Change:
          - Because You've Been Changed!
    - So Think About:
  - What You Have Already Put Off!
    - 3:9b "Seeing That Ye Have Put Off The Old Man With His Deeds!"
      - Those Deeds Include:
        - All Of The Sins Mentioned In This Chapter!
      - Fornication, Uncleanness, Inordinate Affection, Evil Concupiscence, Covetousness, Idolatry, Anger, Wrath, Malice, Blasphemy, Filthy Communication, Lying!
    - When You Put Your Faith In Jesus Christ:
      - You Chose To "Put Off" That Old Man:
        - That Old Nature Because By God's Grace You Were Enabled To Recognize It:
          - As Old & Useless & Fruitless!
    - God Opened Your Eyes:
      - To See That:
        - The New Was Better Than The Old!
        - The Light Was Better Than The Darkness!
        - God's Way Was Better Than Your Ways!

- So Then Why Would You:
  - Go Back? Why Do You Go Back?
    - Remember "Ye Have Put Off The Old Man With His Deeds!"
      - But Also You Need To Remember:
- What You Have Already Put On!
  - 3:10a "And Have Put On The New Man!"
    - That Is The New Nature:
      - That Comes From Christ!
      - It Is New & Different!
      - It Is Alive & Vibrant!
      - It Is Beautiful & Fresh!
  - It Is The Life Of Christ Himself:
    - In You!
- And It This New Man:
  - That Will Enable You:
    - To Put Off Any Of The Remnants:
      - Of That Old Man!
  - IE: It Is Kind Of What Happens To Snakes When Every So Often They Have To Shed Their Skin Their Old Skin, Like Our Old Man & Nature, Is Dead But It Still Surrounds Their Body Their New Skin, Like Our New Man & Nature, Is Alive But The Snake Still Has To Put Forth The Effort To Wriggle Out Of That Old, Dead, Useless Skin!
    - And That's What Christians Are To Do Every Single Day!
      - The Old Man:
        - Is Dead & Useless!
      - The New Man:
        - Is Alive & Well!
      - Keep Wriggling Out Of That Old, Dead, And Useless Nature!
        - Because There's Already Been A Change In Your Person! But Even Further There's Been:

## 3. A Change In Your Perception!

- In The Rest Of 3:10 Paul Wants You To Know:
  - What Your New Man & Nature Is Like:
    - It Has Been "Renewed In The Knowledge After The Image Of Him That Created Him!"
  - The New Nature:
    - That You Have Been Given:
      - Was Created By The Lord Jesus Christ!
        - And So Your New Man:
          - Is Constantly Being Renewed In His Image!
  - This Means That:
    - You Will More & More:
      - Live Like Christ & Look Like Christ:
        - Because Now, You Can Think Like Christ!
          - You Are Being "Renewed In The Knowledge" Of Jesus!
  - And You Will Start To:
    - See Things More & More:
      - The Way Christ Sees Things!
        - And This Change In Your Perception Is What We Find In:
- 3:11 "Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free!"
  - You See In This "New Man" That You've Been Given:
    - All Of Those Old Differences:
      - That Often Caused Division:
        - And Discord Including Those Sins Of Anger & Wrath & Malice:
          - Are No Longer Of Any Significance!
  - Now You Know The Truth:
    - About Those Differences!
      - And Paul Brings Out Four Pairs Of Differences That Often Brought About Prejudice & Discrimination! And Still Does!
- Distinctions In Race:

- Like "Greeks" & "Jews!" - In Christ - In The New Man: - These Kinds Of Differences: - Don't Matter! Or: - Distinctions In Religion: - Like - "Circumcision" & "Uncircumcision!" - In Christ - In The New Man: - These External Differences: - Don't Matter! Or: - Distinctions In Refinement: - Like - "Barbarians" & "Scythians!" - In Christ - In The New Man: - These Differences: - Don't Matter Either! Or: - Distinctions In Rank: - Like - "Bond" & "Free!" - Since You Have Put On: - The "New Man" In Jesus Christ: - You Have Been Given: - A Renewed Heart & Mind & Knowledge: - And Vision! - Now - You Can See All Things: - And All People: - Through The Lenses Of Christ Himself! - This Kind Of Perspective: - Will Bring: - Humility: - When You See Where You've Come From! - Compassion: - When You See The Needs Of Others! - Harmony: - When You See The Church The Way Christ Sees The Church! - And - When You Have This New Perspective: - From Your New Man & Nature: - So Much Of The Anger & Wrath & Malice Of That Old Man Will Disappear! - Especially When You Remember That You've Also Been Given: A Change In Your Priorities! - 3:11b - "But Christ Is All, And In All!" - Again - Paul Is Telling Us What: - This "New Man" & "New Nature" Is Like! - It Is Now - All About: - Christ! - This Is How: - You Will Be Able To: - Keep "Putting Off" & "Mortifying" Those: - Sins Of The Flesh / Your Old Man! - Because - Now: - Both In You & To You: - "Christ Is All, And In All!" - This Means That Your Number One Priority & Desire Is:
- To Please Christ!

- Now "Christ Is All" To You!"
  - All That You Once Were:
    - And All That You Once:
      - Prized & Pursued After:
        - ized & Fuisued Aliel.
          - You Find In Him!
- He Is The All-Sufficient One!
  - And He Is The Only One:
    - Who Can Tame Your Lusts:

## - And Satisfy Your Soul!

- So When You Strive:
  - To Please Him:
    - He Will Enable You:
      - To Mortify & Put Off Everything:
        - That Does *Not* Please Him!
  - Your Priority Is Also Now:
- To Promote Christ!
  - If Christ "Is All" To You Then:
    - Christ Can Be "All" To Anyone & Everyone:
      - No Matter What Their Superficial Differences May Be!
  - It Will Not Matter:
    - What A Person's Race Or Religion Or Level Of Refinement Or Rank & Station In Life:
      - You Will Promote Christ:
        - To Them All!
          - But Also Priority:

- To Portray Christ!
  - That Is Christ Can Be & Should Be:
    - "In All!" "In All":
      - Of Your Feelings!
      - Of Your Thoughts!
      - Of Your Desires!
      - Of Your Deeds!
- As A Christian:
  - You Should Be Able To Say & Sing:
    - From Your Heart:
      - "O I Want To Be Like Jesus!"
        - Because Now With This New Man You Can!

### **Conclusion:**

- 1. Remember Today That In Christ:
  - You've Been Radically Changed!
    - In Christ:
      - Your Priorities Have Changed!
        - And Your Perceptions Have Changed!
          - Because Your Very Person Has Changed!

- 2. You Have:
  - "Put Off The Old Man With His Deeds; And Have Put On The New Man!"
    - So Now Keep Changing!
      - Keep "Putting Off" & Shedding:
        - That Old, Dead, Useless:
          - Skin Of Your Flesh!

- So That:
  - Your New Man Can Shine Through!
    - So That:
      - Christ Himself:
        - May Be Seen In You!
