- I. The First Disciples Encounter Jesus (13-24)
 - A. Jesus was veiled to their sight
 - B. He asks what event they are speaking of
 - C. The men begin to tell Jesus all about what happened at the crucifixion, and the oddity of the empty tomb
- II. Jesus Unfolds The Story of Redemption (25-27)
 - A. Jesus rebukes them for their unbelief
 - B. Jesus then addressed the full story of redemption as revealed in the Scripture
 - C. Beginning with Moses and with all the prophets. (More on this later)...
- III. Jesus Breaks Bread And Reveals Himself (28-35)
 - A. Their eyes were opened
 - B. Their hearts burned within them
 - C. A picture of salvation
 - 1. The Word is rightly taught
 - 2. Jesus reveals Himself
 - 3. Jesus communes with believers
 - 4. Believers are awakened to the truth and glory of the resurrected Christ
- IV. How To Study The Bible
 - A. Jesus gives us a key to interpretation
 - B. The grammar and history of a text are important
 - C. The true interpretive key is Jesus
 - D. Everything in the Bible is about Him in some way
