

Paul's Co-Laborers
Romans 16:21–24

Paul's co-laborers demonstrate to us close relationships that form when serving Christ.

Paul is leading a delegation of the Gentile churches to Jerusalem as a demonstration of the saving power of the world-wide gospel - **Romans 16:25–26**

Timothy, my fellow worker,

- Timothy joined Paul during his second missionary journey - **Acts 16:1–5**
- Timothy worked together in unison with Paul in the ministry - **1 Corinthians 16:10** **And if Timothy comes, see that he may be with you without fear; for he does the work of the Lord, as I also do.**
- Paul's closest friend in ministry was Timothy - **Philippians 2:19–23**

and Lucius, Jason, and Sosipater, my countrymen, greet you.

- These were certainly Hebrew men and possibly men of the tribe of Benjamin.
- It's possible that this is Lucius of Cyrene from Paul's home church of Antioch (Acts 13:1).
- This is probably Jason from Thessalonica who housed Paul and Silas - **Acts 17:1–9**
- Sosipater is the long name for Sopater of Berea - **Acts 19:21; 20:1–4**

I, Tertius, who wrote this epistle, greet you in the Lord.

- Tertius was Paul's amanuensis.
- Tertius must have been careful to write down exactly what Paul dictated to him.
- The Greek is written: *Greet you, I Tertius, the one writing the epistle in the Lord.*

Gaius, my host and the host of the whole church, greets you.

- There are four men named Gaius: Gaius from Macedonia (Acts 19:29), Gaius of Derbe in Lyconia (Acts 20:4), Gaius to whom John wrote his third epistle, and Gaius of Corinth.
- This is the Gaius Paul baptized - **1 Corinthians 1:13–17**
- Gaius used his wealth and possessions to bless the church with hospitality - **1 Peter 4:9** **Be hospitable to one another without grumbling.**

Erastus, the treasurer of the city, greets you,

- He is possibly the same Erastus of Corinth of which a stone inscription states that he financed the paving of the square with his own money.
- There are few noble and high-ranking people who come to Christ - **1 Corinthians 1:26** **For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called.**

and Quartus, a brother.

- Roman slaves were sometimes given names according to rank: *Primus, Secundus, Tertius.*
- Even as a slave ranked fourth, Quartus was a brother serving together with Paul.

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.

The grace of God brings each us ordinary people together to do an extraordinary work, to serve the Lord Jesus Christ in the gospel ministry.
