- I. The Present and Future Reality of Things (1-2)
  - A. Faith displays itself actively in the present
  - B. Three present calls upon God’s people
    - 1. Social obligations (Preserve Justice & Do Righteousness)
    - 2. Religious obligations (Here – Sabbath)
    - 3. Moral obligations (Keep hand from evil)
  - C. Benefit
    - 1. Salvation to come
    - 2. Righteousness revealed
    - 3. Blessing (Present and future)
- II. The Global Zion
  - A. But what about those not under/excluded from the Mosaic covenant? (cf. Deuteronomy 23:1) – the foreigner and the eunuch
  - B. NOT EXCLUDED!
  - C. What does their faith-life look like?
    - 1. It is also, social, religious, and moral
    - 2. It includes a love of God and fellow man
  - D. What is their blessing?
    - 1. A place in “the house”
    - 2. A name better than son/daughter
    - 3. An everlasting name
    - 4. Brought to the “holy mountain”
    - 5. Joyful in house of prayer
    - 6. Their sacrifices are acceptable
  - E. Not just one nation or one set of sheep
