Introduction

 "Just as *He chose us* in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love *He predestined* us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, ... also we have obtained an inheritance, *having been predestined* according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will." (Ephesians 1:4-5,11)

2. The P_____ of Sin; Without Christ, You Were Dead (vv.1-3)

"Men apart from God are spiritual zombies. They are the walking dead, who do not know they are dead. They go through the motions of life, but they do not possess it." John MacArthur

Four Painful Outcomes of Sin:

- Going with the flow of the world (v. 2a)
 "in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world"
- ii. Following the lead of God's enemy (v. 2b)

"according to the prince of the power of the air,

of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience."

iii. Enslaved to your own strong feelings and warped thinking (v. 3a)

"Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh,

indulging the desires of the **flesh** and of the **mind**,"

iv. Under God's judgment (v. 3b)

"and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest"

Total depravity: unable to comprehend, believe or embrace spiritual truths

- "You did not choose Me, but I *chose you*." (John 15:16)
- "There is none righteous, not even one; There is none who understands, There is none who seeks for God;" (Romans 3:10-11)
- "I came that they might have *life*, and might have it abundantly." (John 10:10b)
- "No one can come to Me, *unless* the Father who sent Me *draws* him; and I will raise him up on the last day." (John 6:44)
- "Is it not the rich who oppress you and personally **drag** you into court?" (James 2:6b)
- "They seized Paul and Silas and *dragged* them into the market place before the authorities." (Acts 16:19)

4. God's P_____; In Christ, You Have a Great Future (vv. 7-10)

- i. For His Glory and Our Good (v. 7) "The purpose for which God saved us was not primarily to keep us out of Hell, we were saved primarily so that God could shower His grace and kindness on us." John MacArthur
- ii. For Our Dependence, Not Our Doing (vv. 8-9)
 - "Peter ... to those who *have received a faith* of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus." (2 Peter 1:1)
 - "For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake." (Philippians 1:29)
 - "Who are you, O man who answers back to God. The thing molded will not say to the molder. Why did you make me like this will it?" (Romans 9:20)

- iii. As His Masterpiece, To Accomplish His Pre-Selected Tasks (v. 10)
 - "By this is My Father glorified, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples." (John 15:8)
