



“Ministry Basics”

The Bottom Line
Exodus 3:11-22

It about the:

I. Minister - “Moses said unto God, Who am I” (vs. 11-15)

Remember you are God’s:

- A. **Sidekick** – “Certainly I will be with thee”
- B. **Sent One** – “that I have sent thee”
- C. **Servant** - “ye shall serve God upon this mountain”

II. Master - “What is His name?, What shall I say” (vs. 16-18)

Remind them of God’s:

- A. **Perception** - “have surely visited you and seen”
- B. **Promises** – “And I have said, I will bring you up”
- C. **Presence** – “The Lord God...has met with us”

III. Miserable - “the king of Egypt will not let you go” (vs. 19-22)

Represent:

- A. **Freedom** – “after that he will let you go”
- B. **Favor** – “I will give...favor in the sight of the Egyptians”
- C. **Fullness** – “ye shall spoil the Egyptians”

Sentence Sermon:

*“Ministry is simply caring enough
to lead others closer to Jesus Christ.”*
