Exhortation: Stop Boasting in Men 1 Corinthians 3:21a (CSB)

So let no one boast in human leaders,

- The prohibition of boasting is in the present imperative.
- This is the third imperative in 3:18-21
- "So" shows that futile reasonings lead to self-delusion caused by worldly wisdom
- Those who are God's field, God's building, and God's temple must give God all glory

Theology: The "Why"

1 Corinthians 3:21b (CSB)

- ...for everything is yours-
- God's promises in Christ are not sectarian
- No one who truly believes in Christ crucified will "miss out"
- Therefore boasting must only be in the Lord (1:29-31)
- "Everything" is comprehensive and eternal, as shown in the next verse

Theology: Content of the "Why" <u>1 Corinthians 3:22 (CSB)</u> whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or things present or things to come everything is yours,

- All servants of Christ will participate in God's eternal promises
- There is no particular preacher who has a secret that will make us better off

Boast in the Lord Not Man

1 Corinthians 1:30-31 (CSB)

It is from him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became wisdom from God for us—our righteousness, sanctification, and redemption—in order that, as it is written: Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.

- This truth brackets Paul's teaching from 1:29-3:23
- It will be emphasized again (4:7)

1 Corinthians 1:10, 12, 13a (NASB) Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment...Now I mean this, that each one of you is saying, "I am of Paul," and "I of Apollos," and "I of Cephas," and "I of Christ."...Has Christ been divided?
