1. F Teachers in Jude & 2 Peter

→ **2 Peter 2:18**

2. The A

→ **NOTE: This expression is used in the Greek Old Testament (Septuagint) in Daniel and guess whom it is about?? ANTICHRIST!**

→ **Daniel 11:36**

→ **NOTE: Against whom does the Anti-Christ speak? Against the God of gods—see Deuteronomy 10:17.**

→ **NOTE: Isn't it interesting that the false-teaching infiltrators of Jude's day resembled the Anti-Christ in their bombastic boastful speech?**

→ **2 Thessalonians 2:3-10**

→ **NOTE: How sad that people will fall to the "lying wonders" of Satan because they refuse the "love of the truth" for salvation.**

***(Jude's phrase is not used of the next two but their actions and attitudes illustrate the bombastic pride.)**
