1 Cor 2:3 "I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling."

Mature Christians don't have bad days. Do they?

Do you know what a Hagiography is?

Why was Paul Discouraged?

He was Lonely. He was Penniless. He was Weary. He was Worried.

Are you weary? Are you troubled? Are you alone?

Perhaps Paul was fearing additional persecution

How did God encourage him?

God sent him companions in ministry. Friends. Co Laborers.

Aquila and Prisca

Silas and Timothy

They also returned with good news.

What ought a church to be for the sheep?

They also had donated mission money (2 Cor 11:9; Phil 4:11-12).

"Paul was occupied with the word."

God Blessed Paul's Ministry

Crispus, Titius Justus, others.

God Directly Encouraged Paul

Jesus spoke to him in a vision (Acts 9:12; 16:9-10; 23:11; 27:23-24).

In verses 9-10 we have 3 commands and 3 promises given to Paul.

But one comforting message from God. I am with you (Ex 3:12; Josh 1:5, 9; Jer 1:8).

I will protect you. I will make you fruitful.

Paul stayed 18 months in Corinth.

Who was Sosthenes?

How was the ruling beneficial for the early church?
