 - a. What joy is not
 - Giddy emotionalism caused by external means: Phil. 4:4
 - Dependent on circumstances: Habakkuk 3:17-18
 - b. What joy is
 - Comes from the truth of the Gospel believed and received Luke 2:10-11, Acts 8:39, Acts 13:44-52, Rom. 15:13
 - A by-product of our new life in Christ: John 15:11; 16:24
 - Known by the presence of God: Psalm 16:11
 - Given by the Holy Spirit: Gal. 5:22
 - Not sought in and of itself: Jer. 29:12-13
 - Strength for the Christian Life: Nehemiah 8:10
 - Fragile, not in itself, but our experience of it: Psalm 51:12
 - c. When this command is to be obeyed
 - Always: 1 Thess. 5:16
 - On every occasion: Phil 4:4
