The Beginning of the Missionary Era (Acts 12:25-13:4) Part 1

Luke reached a decisive point in his narrative: first mission from Antioch Barnabas and Paul: are the first missionaries sent out from the church The momentous step is taken to take the Gospel "to the ends of the earth"

I. Barnabas & Paul: Missionaries to the Ends of the Earth (12:25-3:4)

A. <u>A diverse church and a diverse leadership (13:1)</u>

Antioch had in its membership five resident prophets and teachers

Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Simone of Cyrene, Lucius of Cyrene,

Manaen, Saul, who came to be known as Paul

- Vs 4. They went down to Seleucia & from there sailed to Cyprus
