Introduction

- I. We should want to be a church of peacemakers, dealing with conflict and sin in the way God calls us to deal with it.
- II. The text teaches us the blessedness of peacemaking God's way.

## Peacemakers: (1) The Blessed Peacemakers

The Idea - what is a peacemaker?
A. We learn what peacemaking is from God, Who is the Peacemaker.

- B. Peacemaking is the right, godly response to conflict that arises in our lives; the right response to sins committed against us.
  - 1. We need to learn about peacemaking because there is conflict in our lives.
  - 2. A peacemaker sees conflict as an opportunity to glorify God, serve others, and grow to be like Christ.
