

Daniel – Kingdoms, Beasts, 70 Sevens

“The head of this image was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its middle and thighs of bronze, its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. As you looked, a stone was cut out by no human hand, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, all together were broken in pieces, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, so that not a trace of them could be found. But the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.” – Daniel 2:32-35

“I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the great sea. And four great beasts came up out of the sea, different from one another. The first was like a lion and had eagles' wings. Then as I looked its wings were plucked off, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man, and the mind of a man was given to it. And behold, another beast, a second one, like a bear. It was raised up on one side. It had three ribs in its mouth between its teeth; and it was told, ‘Arise, devour much flesh.’ After this I looked, and behold, another, like a leopard, with four wings of a bird on its back. And the beast had four heads, and dominion was given to it. After this I saw in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, terrifying and dreadful and exceedingly strong. It had great iron teeth; it devoured and broke in pieces and stamped what was left with its feet. It was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns. I considered the horns, and behold, there came up among them another horn, a little one, before which three of the first horns were plucked up by the roots. And behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking great things.” – Daniel 7:2-8

The Seventieth Seven

“Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal both vision and prophet, and to anoint a most holy place. Know therefore and understand that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to the coming of an anointed one, a prince, there shall be seven weeks. Then for sixty-two weeks it shall be built again with squares and moat, but in a troubled time. And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one shall be cut off and shall have nothing. And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. Its end shall come with a flood, and to the end there shall be war. Desolations are decreed. And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator.” – Daniel 9:24-27

“...and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which she is to be nourished for 1,260 days.” – Revelation 12:6

“The woman was given the two wings of the great eagle so that she might fly from the serpent into the wilderness, to the place where she is to be nourished for a time, and times, and half a time. “ – Revelation 12:14

“He shall speak words against the Most High, and shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and shall think to change the times and the law; and they shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.” – Daniel 7:25

*“Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, **we ask you, brothers, not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed**, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come. Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God. Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? And you know*

*what is restraining him now so that he may be revealed in his time. For **the mystery of lawlessness is already at work**. Only **he who now restrains it will do so until he is out of the way**. And **then the lawless one will be revealed**, whom the Lord Jesus will kill with the breath of his mouth and bring to nothing by the appearance of his coming. The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of Satan with all power and false signs and wonders, and with all wicked deception for those who are perishing, **because they refused to love the truth and so be saved**. Therefore God sends them a **strong delusion, so that they may believe what is false, in order that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.**"*

– 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

*"For this **we declare to you by a word from the Lord**, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. JESUS
(Mt. 24)

"They will deliver you up to tribulation and **put you to death**...hated by all nations for my name's sake... then **many will fall away**...betray one another...hate one another...the love of many will grow cold... when you see **the abomination of desolation** ... standing in the holy place... then there will be **great tribulation**..." (Mt. 24:9-21)

PAUL
(1 Th. 5:3)

"While people are saying, **'Peace and safety'**, destruction will come on them suddenly" (1Th.5:3)

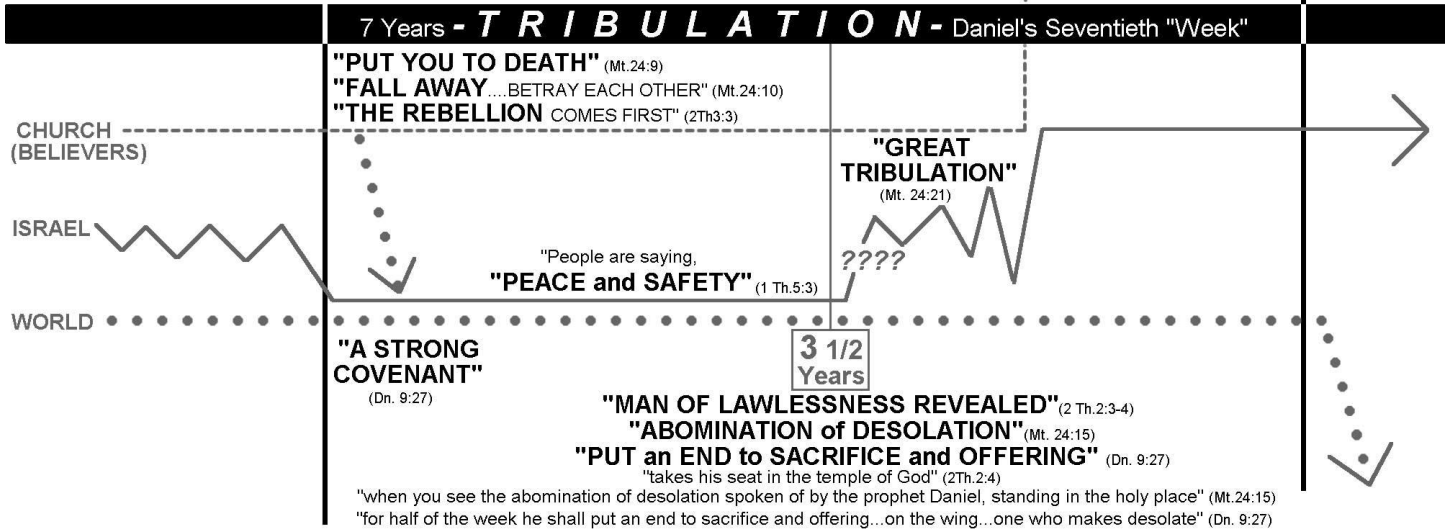
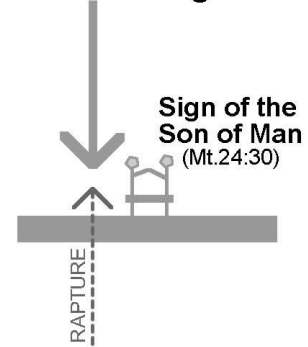
PAUL
(2 Th. 2:3-4)

"That day will not come unless:
1) **the rebellion comes** first, and
2) the **man of lawlessness is revealed**, the son of destruction,
a) who **opposes** and **exalts himself** against every so-called god or object of worship,
b) so that he **takes his seat in the temple of God**,
c) **proclaiming himself to be God**

DANIEL
(Dn. 9:27)

"He shall make **a strong covenant** with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall **put an end to sacrifice** and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate." (Dn.9:27)

Second Coming



Jesus identifies how he will NOT return at the Second Coming.

This is a warning to the Jews, and to others, who are waiting for a man to appear in history as the Messiah.

*"Then if anyone says to you,
'Look, here is the Christ!'*

or

'There he is!'

do not believe it.

For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.

See, I have told you beforehand. So, if they say to you,...."

FALSE OPTION #1 - THE MILITANT

" 'Look, he is in the wilderness'

[...forming his military to advance into Israel and capture Jerusalem],

do not go out

[...to join the forces of the antichrist]."

FALSE OPTION #2 - THE POLITICIAN

" 'Look, he is in the inner rooms'

[...negotiating treaties and forming political alliances],

do not believe it

[...,because this is the work of the antichrist and the false prophet]."

THE ONLY OPTION - THE APPEARANCE OF THE SIGN OF THE SON OF MAN

"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There he is!' do not believe it. For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.

See, I have told you beforehand. So, if they say to you, 'Look, he is in the wilderness,' do not go out.

If they say, 'Look, he is in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. For **as the lightning comes** from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the **coming of the Son of Man.**

Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather. Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then

will **appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man,** and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." (Matthew 24:23-31)
