Opening observations

- Samuel's appearance caused great fear: 1 Sam 16:4-5
- Reverence and respect are fitting: Ex. 19:10-13; Lev. 10:3
- ➤ Preparation (sanctify thyself) is Biblical: 1 Cor. 11:26-30
- I. 1 Cor. 11:17-24 is to guide believers how to use the Lord's Supper
 - A. Address: saints who in ignorance and/or neglect dishonored LS
 - 1. converted sinners can eat 'unworthily'
 - 2. to such saints, the Supper will not be spiritually profitable (v. 30)
 - B. The Lord's Supper Form is to aid us in this preparation
 - 1. by examination
 - 2. by education
 - C. Purpose: not to keep people **from** but to guide God's people **to** use the Lord's Supper properly
- II. Brief exposition of the Biblical teaching of the Lord's Supper Form
 - 1. Form is written to help us to celebrate LS to our comfort
 - 2. Form guides us to examine: Am I a true and upright believer?
 - a. 1 Cor 11:24: implies the Supper is for believers (John 10:25-27)
 - b. How do I know I am one of His sheep?
 - examine whether ye are in the faith (2 Cor. 13:5)
 - examine the 3 spiritual vital signs
 - 3. Examination:
 - a. Do I repent of my sins I discover in myself?
 - consider your own sins
 - consider the curse due to your sins (Ps. 51:4)
 - consider the weight of your sins thru cross of Jesus
 - b. Do I believe (trust) in Jesus Christ as only Name?
 - Holy Spirit leads from sin to salvation through faith
 - emphasis in Form: Do I believe in Gospel of Jesus?
 - yet emphasis is not on the faith but Object of faith
 - c. Do I live a converted/converting life?
 - measure is not in the level of attainment in holiness
 - measure is in the habit of heart towards holiness
 - d. Who are now the 'worthy partakers?"
 - 4. The closing or opening of Table: 1 Cor. 11:28
 - a. Formal church discipline bars officially

- b. Personal examination is to bar you personally: 1 Cor. 10:21
- 5. The pastoral section to the tender and contrite hearts
 - a. Who usually are deepest affected by 1 Cor. 11:27?
 - b. What do all upright souls confess?
 - Romans 7:12-25
