## INTRODUCTION

- This chapter is a healthy corrective to the popular notion that education in Israel was a harsh and mindless affair in which "demands for obedience to rules were learned by rote and drummed in by incessant rebukes, simplistic promises, and above all, zealous thrashings." (M. Fox)
- A 22 verse, single line, alphabetic poem, both artistic and signifying completeness.

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## THE DILIGENT PURSUIT OF WISDOM (1-4)

- <sup>1</sup> My child, **listen** to what I say, and **treasure** my commands.
- <sup>2</sup> **Tune** your ears to wisdom, and **concentrate** on understanding.
- <sup>3</sup> **Cry out** for insight, and **ask** for understanding.
- <sup>4</sup> Search for them as you would for silver; seek them like hidden treasures.

THE FURTHER REWARDS OF WISDOM (8-11)	
<sup>8</sup> He <b>guards</b> the paths of the just	
and <b>protects</b> those who are faithful to him. <sup>9</sup> Then you will understand what is <b>right</b> , <b>just</b> , and <b>fair</b> ,	
and you will find <b>the right way</b> to go.  10 <b>For</b> wisdom will <b>enter your heart</b> ,	
and knowledge will <b>fill you with joy</b> .  11 <b>Wise choices</b> will watch over you.

<sup>12</sup> Wisdom will save you from <b>evil people</b> ,	
from those whose words are twisted.  13 These men turn from the right way	
to walk down dark paths.  14 They take pleasure in doing wrong,	
and they enjoy the twisted ways of evil.	
<sup>15</sup> Their actions are crooked, and their ways are wrong.

THE PROTECTIVE POWER OF WISDOM (16-19)  16 Wisdom will save you from the immoral woman,	
from the seductive words of the promiscuous woman.	
<sup>17</sup> She has abandoned her husband and ignores the covenant she made before God.	
<sup>18</sup> Entering her house leads to death; it is the road to the grave.	
<sup>19</sup> The man who visits her is doomed.	
He will never reach the paths of life.

THE ULTIMATE REWARD FOR WISDOM (20- 22)	
<sup>20</sup> So <b>follow</b> the steps of the good,	
and <b>stay on</b> the paths of the righteous. <sup>21</sup> For <b>only</b> the godly will <b>live in the land,</b>	
and those with integrity will <b>remain in it.</b> 22 But the wicked will be <b>removed</b> from the land.
