## **BATMAN, MOVIES AND MURDER! (Part 2)**

TEXT: 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

34 Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.

"The mass shooting at a 'Dark Knight Rises' screening last week has Hollywood quietly squirming...'Like every person who works in movies and is following this event, I'm asking myself what are we responsible for, if anything,' said Rob Cohen, a director-producer of edgy films such as...'Stealth' [etc.]...'Some say we're complicit in this violence and I'm not sure we are,' he said. 'But, it does give me great pause...now have to look deeper'...Kurt Sutter, the writer-producer of such TV shows as 'Sons of Anarchy' and 'The Shield,' is also looking inward. 'Woke up to the news about shooting,' he said in a Twitter message last Friday after 12 people were killed and 58 injured. 'This kinda thing always makes me question my liberal use of violence in storytelling'...Independent producer Harvey Weinstein, who has released all of director Quentin Tarantino's violence-laden films...suggested to the *Huffington Post* that he, Tarantino, Martin Scorsese and 'all of us who deal in violence in movies' should sit down...and discuss our role in that."

"In the wake of the Aurora shootings, there's a conversation emerging over the amount of violence in the movie industry, and the industry's newest pacifist is also one of its most unlikely: **Harvey Weinstein.** Harvey Weinstein, of all people, wants Hollywood to review the amount of violence that makes its way into movies. He called for an A-list sit down to talk about how violence in movies is portrayed in an interview with the *Huffington Post...* The suggestion may seem a little ludicrous coming from Harvey Weinstein. He and his brother have financed some seriously violent fare... He said he's wrestled with some of the more violent scenes presented to him... 'It's a question that I wrestle with all the time. I've been involved with violent movies, and then I've said at a certain point, 'I can't take it anymore. Please cut it'... My heart goes out to those kids and those families,' Weinstein said."

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## "Legendary" Director Peter Bogdanovich:

"Violence on the screen has increased tenfold. It's almost pornographic. In fact, it is pornographic. Video games are violent, too. It's all out of control. I can see where it would drive somebody crazy...The fact that these tentpole movies are all violent comic book movies doesn't speak well for our society. Obviously, there is violence in the world, and you have to deal with it. But there are other ways to do it without showing people getting blown up...Today, there's a general numbing of the audience. There's too much murder and killing. You make people insensitive by showing it all the time. The body count in pictures is huge. It numbs the audience into thinking it's not so terrible. Back in the '70s, I asked Orson Welles what he thought was happening to pictures, and he said, 'We're brutalizing the audience. We're going to end up like the Roman circus, live at the Coliseum.' The respect for human life seems to be eroding...'"

And when someone who's spent their life making movies says it's gone too far, maybe our pop-culture tastemakers need to start rethinking the depths they're willing to go to to turn a profit."

"Violent movies: Addictive as trans fats and just as dangerous - A shaken young couple, in a television interview, had survived the Aurora, Colo. movie massacre and saved their 4-month-old baby...But what were they doing with a 4-month-old baby at a screening of an intense, violent, loud film starting at midnight? Even if that child was not watching, the high-intensity soundtrack would be disturbing enough...the dividing line between video games and movies has blurred. Games become movies, movies become games...Americans and American youth are now as addicted to 'action' films as they are to trans fats. Both addictions are equally hard to quit...The question in the wake of the Aurora movie massacre should be, 'What kind of America do we want?' An America in which we drug attention-deficit-disorder-diagnosed kids in response to their diet of sugar, video games and violent films?...An America de-sensitized to human suffering and pain, because of the numbing effect of movie violence which, no matter how gross, is not, after all, real?"

#### Jack Cafferty's CNN blog (with a Batman pictute), asks, What should be done about violent movies?

"Everyone settled in easy chairs...The lights slowly dimmed...The first movie began.
