ENABLED TO SPEAK, ENABLED TO SERVE

Ephesians 4:11-16

- 1. God has given all of His children "the gift".
- 2. God has given all of His children some gifts.
 - a. Sign Gifts The sign gifts were authenticating gifts or gifts of **credential** for first century Christians to authenticate their message.
 - b. **Speaking** Gifts (1 Peter 4:11) The speaking gifts are divinely imparted abilities of **communication** for the purpose of audibly spreading God's truth.
 - i. Apostles The meaning of the word apostle is simply 'sent ones'.
 - ii. **Prophets** He is a **proclaimer** of a message.
 - iii. Evangelists It is that person who is able to find an opening in **personal** and in **public** ways to tell the good news.
 - iv. Pastors (shepherds)- The gift given that combines several gifts needed for the care and teaching of a body of believers.
 - v. **Teachers** The teacher is delighted to study and learn so that he can **explain** and instruct others, either one-on-one, or in a group setting the wondrous truths of God's Word.
 - vi. **Exhortation** Exhortation is the gift of encouragement, **comfort** and motivation.
 - vii. Wisdom/Knowledge Wisdom is the judicious use of knowledge meant to edify and not tear down others.

- viii. **Discernment** This is the ability to differentiate between truth and error: between false and true teachers.
- c. **Servina** Gifts (1 Peter 4:11) 'Ministry' is the act of rendering **service** or **helping** perhaps individually or in a group effort to meet needs in the body of Christ (Rom. 12:7; 1 Cor. 12:28; Eph. 4:12). Here are some basic qualities or gifts that show up in 'servants':
 - i. Faith (1 Cor. 12:9) This is extraordinary faith for the supplying of needs or to carry on under insurmountable odds.
 - ii. Mercy/Compassion (Rom. 12:8) A selfexplanatory gift which is the gift that we all really need.
 - iii. Giving with simplicity (Rom. 12:8) not duplicity! The aift of aiving is no doubt linked to the gift of gaining.
 - iv. **Leadership** (ruling) (Rom. 12:8) Leaders rule, govern and **motivate** people to work in unity.
 - v. **Administration** (1 Cor. 12:28) they **organize** people. They help people stay on task.
- 3. The essential requirement concerning spiritual gifts is availability (Rom. 12:1-2).
