Journey Through Acts "He Shall Direct Thy Paths" Acts 15:36 - 16:8

Introduction:

- 1. Tonight As We Continue Our:
 - Journey Through Acts:
 - We Are Back In The City Of Antioch:
 - In Syria Where Paul & Barnabas:
 - Kept On "Teaching & Preaching The Word Of The Lord!"
 - So Let's Head Back:
 - To Acts 15 Where After The:
 - Church Council In Jerusalem:
 - The Church Remains United:
 - In Her Mission And Is About To Be On The Move Again!
- 2. And So There In Antioch:
 - After A Period Of About Two Years:
 - In 15:36 We Read:
 - "And some days after Paul said unto Barnabas, Let us go again and visit our brethren in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, and see how they do!"
 - Paul & Barnabas:
 - Had A Heart For The People Of God:
 - And They Longed To See:
 - How They Were Doing!
 - They Were Now All Part Of:
 - The Family Of God And In Spite Of The Hardships They Faced:
 - They Were Ready To Go Back:
 - Because They Loved Them!
- 3. And What We Will Find:
 - In These Verses That Introduce Us To:
 - This Second Missionary Journey:
 - Is An Example Of Some Of The Ways:
 - That The Lord Directs His Servants:
 - And His Church!
 - Even As We Are Told:
 - In The Book Of Proverbs:
 - Proverbs 3:6 "In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths!"
 - But Sometimes The Direction Of The Lord In Our Lives:
 - Can Be Quite Surprising!
 - And This Is Certainly The Case:
 - In 15:38-41 Where We Find:
- 1. The Lord's Direction Through Disputes!
 - Because As Paul & Barnabas Were Making Plans:
 - To Go Visit Their Brethren:
 - Something Happened Between The Two Of Them!
 - 15:38-41 "And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark. / 38 But Paul thought not good to take him with them, who departed from them from Pamphylia, and went not with them to the work. / 39 And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus; / 40 And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God. / 41 And he went through Syria and Cilicia, confirming the churches!"
 - In Spite Of The Good Desire:
 - Both Paul & Barnabas Had To Visit Those New Christians:
 - We Just Read About:
 - A New Contention!
 - Simply Put Barnabas Wanted To Take John Mark:
 - Who Was His Nephew Along With Them!

- But Paul Didn't!
 - 15:38 He "Thought Not Good To Take Him!"
- Because As Paul Saw It:
 - John Mark Had Deserted The Ministry:
 - Just As They Were About To Begin The Harshest Phase Of That:
 - First Missionary Journey!
 - He Is Referring All The Way Back To:
 - 13:13 When After Their Visit To Cyprus "They came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem!"
- Now We Are Not Told:
 - Why John Mark Left:
 - But It Is Clear From This Passage:
 - That It Was Not On Good Terms!
- But For This Second Trip:
 - Barnabas Wanted To Give His Nephew:
 - Another Chance But Paul Did Not Think:
 - That This Was A Wise Course Of Action!
- And In The Words Of 15:39:
 - "The contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other!"
 - Now Luke In His Recording Of This Dispute Does Not Take A Side In This Dispute!
 - He Does Not Tell Us Who Was Right Or Who Was Wrong!
 - And So It Is Probably Best For Us Not To Take Sides Either Even Though Many People Do!
- Suffice It To Say:
 - As One Writer Did:
 - Barnabas Was Probably Right:
 - When It Came To:
 - Christian Feeling! And:
 - Paul Was Probably Right:
 - When It Came To:
 - Christian Reason!
 - But It Is Clear That:
 - At This Stage Of Their Relationship:
 - And Ministry Two Good & Godly Men Had To "Agree To Disagree" And They Both Had Their Reasons For Doing So!
- Now This Is A Hard Thing For Us:
 - To Read! After All That Paul & Barnabas:
 - Went Through Together!
 - To Let Something Like This Get Between Them!
 - But God Was About To Show That Even Through Contention He Can Still Direct His Church!
 - And He Did!
- Because Even After This Contention:
 - The Work & The Plans:
 - Did Not Change! Instead There Was:
- A New Commission!
 - 15:39b-40 "And so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus; / And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God!"
 - Now We Are Only Told Here That:
 - Paul & Silas Were Commissioned By The Church In Antioch To Go On This Second Missionary Journey!
 - But Barnabas & Mark Left Antioch As Well! And Where Did They Go? Back To The Old Stomping Grounds Of Barnabas Cyprus!
 - So Even Though Their Forces Were Divided:
 - Both Paul & Barnabas Carried Out Their Mutual Desire:
 - To Visit Their "Brethren In Every City" Where They Had "Preached The Word Of The Lord!" (15:36)

- I Don't Believe Barnabas Stopped:
 - Serving Just To Go Home To Cyprus!
 - No They Both Appear To Carry Out Their Plans & Ministries!
- Because We Still Read About:
 - Both Barnabas & John Mark:
 - In The Letters Of Paul!
 - In His Letter To The Colossian Church:
 - Paul Encourages Them To Receive Barnabas If He Comes To Them!
 - And In His Letter To Timothy:
 - Paul Says That John Mark Is Even "Profitable To [Him] For The Ministry!"
 - So This Dispute In Antioch:
 - Was Short Lived!
 - And As Brothers In Christ They Were Willing To Forbear & To Forgive Each Other So That The Ministry Would Not Be Blamed!
- But In Acts This Is The Last Time:
 - We Read About Barnabas Or Mark:
 - And Our Attention Now Turns To Paul & His New Partner Silas Who Was One Of The Representatives From The Jerusalem Church!
 - And So The Two Of Them Embark On:
- A New Confirmation!
 - 15:41 "And he went through Syria and Cilicia, confirming the churches!"
 - Since Barnabas Went To Cyprus With Mark:
 - That Freed Paul & Silas To Take The Land Routes Back To Those Towns & Cities:
 - That Caused Great Pain & Suffering For Paul!
- But Even Through This Dispute Between Paul & Barnabas:
 - We Can See The Direction Of The Lord!
 - In His Providence God Can Take:
 - Even Our Weaknesses & Failures:
 - To Accomplish His Will In This World!
 - But Then As We Begin Acts 16:
 - We Can Also See:

2. The Lord's Direction Through Dilemmas!

- Like The Dilemma We Read About In:
 - 16:1-5 "Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father was a Greek: / 2 Which was well reported of by the brethren that were at Lystra and Iconium. / 3 Him would Paul have to go forth with him; and took and circumcised him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek. / 4 And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the decrees for to keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem. / 5 And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily!"
 - Now We Can Be Sure That Paul Was:
 - Overjoyed When He Returned To:
 - Derbe & Lystra & Iconium!
 - Especially When He Heard About The Testimony Of Timothy!
 - And How God Saved This Young Man:
 - And How He Grew!
 - But There Was A Dilemma:
 - About Timothy Because Of His Family Ties!
 - Even Though His Father:
 - Was A Gentile His Mother:
 - Was A Jew And That Made Timothy A Jew As Well!
 - But Timothy Had Not Been Circumcised:
 - And That Would Be An Obstacle
 - In Sharing The Gospel To The Jews In His Hometown!
 - Well It Didn't Seem Like Much Of A Dilemma For Paul!
 - Because In 16:3 He "Took And Circumcised Him Because Of The Jews Which Were In Those Quarters!"

- And We See From This:

- An Example Of Grace!
 - Paul Did Not Want There To Be Any:
 - Man-Made Obstacle To Get In The Way:
 - Of The Gospel!
 - Paul Knew That Circumcision Meant Nothing For The Christian!
 - But It Did Mean Something For The Jews!
 - And So "Unto The Jews He Became A Jew" So That He "Might By All Means Save Some!"
 - The Circumcision Of Timothy:
 - Had Nothing To Do With His Salvation!
 - It Only Had To Do With Keeping The Doors Open For The Gospel To The Jews!
 - And So A New Member Joins The Team:
 - Of Paul & Silas Young Timothy!
 - And As They Travel They Share:
- An Exhortation Of Grace!
 - In 16:4 "And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the decrees for to keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem!"
 - This Is Where Things Could Have Become:
 - A Dilemma For Paul & Timothy & The Churches!
 - According To The Jerusalem Council:
 - Circumcision Was Not Required:
 - For Salvation!
 - But Paul Had Timothy:
 - Circumcised After His Salvation:
 - For The Sake Of The Jews!
 - Christians Still Struggle:
 - With This Ouestion!
 - And Sometimes Still Wrestle With What This Means For Us & Our Ministries Today!
 - But It Is Clear That Neither Paul Nor Timothy Nor The Churches Saw Any Contradiction In These Actions!
 - They Sought To Live & To Serve:
 - In A Way That Manifested The Grace Of Christ:
 - To This World! And That Is Why In 16:5, There Is Further:
- An Establishment In Grace!
 - 16:5 "And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily!"
- And So Even Through This Dilemma:
 - We Can See The Direction Of The Lord!
 - In His Providence God Can Take:
 - Even Our Dilemmas & Unanswered Questions:
 - To Further His Work In This World!
 - But Then We Can Also See:

3. The Lord's Direction Through Doubts!

- Which We Read About In:
 - 16:6-8 "Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia, / 7 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not. / 8 And they passing by Mysia came down to Troas!"
 - Paul & Silas Clearly Had A Plan:
 - In Mind As They Traveled Through The Interior Of What Is Today:
 - Modern Turkey!
 - After They Visited:
 - The Churches In:
 - Phrygia & Galatia Likely Where:
 - The Four Cities Of The First Missionary Journey Were Located:
 - They Sought To:
 - "Preach The Word In Asia!"
 - More Than Likely This Meant That Paul Set His Sights On The Capital City Of That

Province - Ephesus - Which Was Further West!

- But The Lord Had Other Plans!
 - It Wasn't Yet Time For Paul To Visit That Part Of Asia! So They:
- "Were Forbidden Of The Holy Ghost!"
 - Somehow God Changed Their Direction!
 - Now We're Not Sure How:
 - Whether Through A Voice From Heaven Or A Dream Or Even Providential Circumstances:
 - But I'm Sure That, At Some Point, Paul & Silas & Timothy Wondered:
 - Why? Why Lord?
 - Why Not Asia?
 - Well Without An Answer According To:
 - 16:7 They Then "Assayed To Go Into Bithynia" Which Was Further North!
 - But Once Again The Lord Had Other Plans For Them!
 - So
- "The Spirit Suffered Them Not!"
 - Once Again Somehow God Changed Their Direction!
 - And I'm Sure Even More They Must Have Wondered:
 - Why? Why Lord?
 - Why Not Bithynia?
 - But Without An Answer According To:
 - 16:8 They "Came Down To Troas!"
- And In Troas:
 - They Waited For Further Instruction & Direction:
 - From The Lord!
 - And As They Waited They Probably Thought About All The Ways:
 - The Lord Had Directed Their Paths!

Conclusion:

- 1. Through Disputes & Through Dilemmas & Through Doubts!
 - Probably Even More:
 - Than Are Recorded For Us Here In Acts!
 - But There Was No Doubt:
 - That The Holy Spirit Was Guiding Them Through It All!
- 2. And The Same Is True:
 - For You & For Us Today!
 - The Lord Makes This Promise:
 - That As You "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. / In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths!"
 - So Even Through:
 - The Disputes & Dilemmas & Doubts:
 - Of Your Own Life Remember:
 - That Even Through These:
 - The Lord Is Directing Your Path!
 - So Like Paul:
 - Keep Your Trust In Him!
 - After All As Job Once Said:
 - "But He knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold!" (Job 23:10)

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
