**Sermon Series: Romans** 

**Sermon Text:** Romans 1:3-5 Obedience of Faith in God's Son

## In the Gospel God calls you to render and call for the obedience of faith.

The Obedience of Faith—"believing obedience" "evangelical obedience"

- 1) Render and call for the obedience of faith because our Lord Jesus Christ is God's eternal Son.
  - a) "concerning His Son" (v. 3a)—God's Son before incarnate as David's seed (cf. 8:3 "by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh")
  - b) Eternal Son—The Father is the Father because He has never been without His Son
  - c) **Application**: Divine Authority
- 2) Render and call for the obedience of faith because our Lord Jesus Christ is David's royal Son.
  - a) "according to the flesh" (v. 3c)—sphere of humanity; incarnation
  - b) "born of the seed of David" (v. 3b)—Davidic Covenant included promise of a son who would (2 Sam. 7:4-17; 1 Chron. 17:3-15)
    - i) Build a House for God's Name
    - ii) Sit on David's Throne Forever
    - iii) Be God's Obedient Son
  - c) **Application**: Divine Condescension
    - i) Christ builds us together as God's dwelling place.
    - ii) Christ pacifies your will and rules you in God's Kingdom.
    - iii) Christ gave perfect obedience to the Father for you.
- 3) Render and call for the obedience of faith because our Lord Jesus Christ is God's risen Son.
  - a) "according to the Spirit of Holiness" (v. 4b)—sphere of Spirit; Spirit's ministry in life of Incarnate Christ
  - b) "by His resurrection from the dead" (v. 4c)—the resurrection of the people of God first-fruit in Christ
  - c) "and was appointed Son of God" (v. 4a)—The Messianic God-Man; the Incarnate Christ
  - d) "in power" (v. 4a)—Christ was exalted after His humiliation was complete; His humanity is exalted in power
  - e) Application: Resurrection Power to Glorify Christ (v. 5 "for the sake of His name")
    - i) Power to live for Christ's glory.
    - ii) Power to bear witness for Christ's glory.
    - iii) Assurance that Christ is Lord of the nations.

**Doxology:** To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood and made us a kingdom, priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. (Rev. 1:5b-6)
