

A Man After God's Own Heart 1 Samuel 13:14

The book of 1 Samuel is an introduction to the kingdom of Israel

The book of 1 Samuel contrasts King Saul and King David.

The book of 1 Samuel is the record of God's establishment of David as King.

The key verse of the book of 1 Samuel is 13:14.

Reasons to study the life of David:

- 1) David is a principal character in God's story.
- 2) David's relationship with God teaches us about God.
- 3) David's life teaches us practical wisdom for Christian living.
- 4) David is at the climax of Israel.
- 5) David is a man like us.
- 6) David is a type of Christ.
- 7) Christ fulfills all as the Son of David.

The people made a choice - 1 Samuel 12:13

- Wrong timing **Deuteronomy 17:14–20**
- Wrong reason 1 Samuel 8:1-7, 19-20
- Wrong man 1 Samuel 9:2; 10:17-24; 13

Saul made a choice - 1 Samuel 13:1-7

- Samuel gave Saul three signs to confirm he would be king 1 Samuel 10:1-9
- Samuel gave Saul a prophetic word 1 Samuel 10:8
- Two years later, God tested Saul 1 Samuel 13:1-7
- Saul chose to disobey the prophetic word of God 1 Samuel 13:8–14a

God made a choice - 1 Samuel 13:14

- God made Saul king because the people demanded a king 1 Samuel 8:22 So the LORD said to Samuel, "Heed their voice, and make them a king."
- God made Saul king to expose Israel's sin Psalm 81:102 I am the LORD your God, Who
 brought you out of the land of Egypt; Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it. But My
 people would not heed My voice, And Israel would have none of Me. So I gave them
 over to their own stubborn heart, To walk in their own counsels.
- God chose to remove Saul Hosea 13:11 I gave you a king in My anger And took him away in My wrath.
- God chose His own king Psalm 78:67–72; 2 Samuel 7:20 Now what more can David say to You? For You, Lord GOD, know Your servant. For Your word's sake, and according to Your own heart, You have done all these great things, to make Your servant know them.

What choices have you made?
We are all at "Gilgal" and God is testing... What will we do?
Will you choose to obey God's timing, God's way, and God's word?
