 - Isaiah 1-12 The message of a prophet to His people (Judah) - God gives promises of blessing amidst warnings of pending punishment for wickedness.
 - A Rebellious Vine: Judah deserves immediate punishment for their wickedness (Chapters 1-5).
 - A Holy Vision: Judah receives a prophet and a call to repent (Chapter 6).
 - A Mysterious Virgin: Judah receives immediate deliverance (Child #1, 3), but future punishment, and future blessing after punishment (Child #2, 4) (Chapters 7-12).
