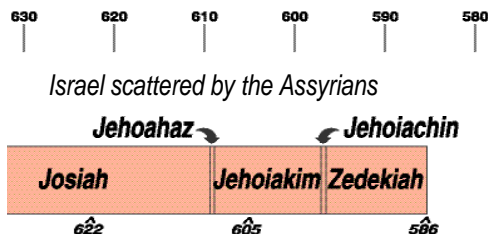
### 1. Convinced of sin's destruction

- persecution  
Jer. 26:20-23; 36:21-24
- Nebuchadnezzar's first “visit”

#### c. reign of **Jehoiachin**

- young king, brief reign  
2 Chr. 36:9; 2 Ki. 24:8  
Deut. 24:16; Ex. 20:5

- further judgments  
Jer. 22:24-30; 2 Sam. 7:17

#### d. reign of **Zedekiah**

- rebellion with a different face  
2 Chr. 36:11-14
- God's certain judgment for sin

- price tag for calling sin “sin”  
Jer. 26:24; 36:21-26; 38
