III. The final hour ushers in the final judgment day

- A. Scripture speaks of the solemn universal judgment:
 - 1. Acts 3:19-23; 17:30-31; Rev. 20:11-15; Zeph. 2:1-3; 3:8
 - 2. Paul used the reality of that day of God's universal judgment as motive to get right with God (Acts 17:30-31)
 - a. Who will we meet on the throne? (2 Cor. 5:10; John 5:20)
- B. The world has never witnessed such a majestic moment
 - 1. We will stand with *resurrected bodies* before Jesus Christ as our Judge a. He will be revealed in His full glory (Dan. 7:9-10; Rev. 20:11)
 - b. much prayer will be heard that day (Rev. 6:12-17)
 - 2. John saw in vision this moment Jesus often preached about: Rev. 20:12 a. Matt. 24:30-31: the elect shall be gathered before His throne first
 - b. Luke 17:34-36; Matt. 25:32-33: painful separations will happen
 - 3. Be comforted, trembling believers in Jesus Christ
 - a. You will not only meet your Judge: *He will be your Savior whom you trust and your Lord whom you obey* (Rom. 10:11-13)
 - b. Be comforted also that *He will reward you graciously for all you did* out of love for Him (Heb. 6:10; Matt. 19:29)
 - d. But slothful and indulgent believers will suffer loss: 1 Cor. 3:11-15

- 4. Be warned who live in disobedience to the law and Gospel: 2 Thess. 1:7-10 a. Jesus will be the Judge of all the wicked (Rev. 21:8)
 - b. Jesus will judge all the secrets of men (Rom. 2:16; Heb. 4:13)
 - c. Jesus will judge according to all we have done (Rom. 2:6; Rev. 20:12)
 - d. Jesus will judge one deed as worst (John 3:19; Matt. 11:23-24)
 - e. Jesus will judge by various books (Rev. 20:12)
 - book of the natural law written on our heart
 - book of the revelation of God's Word
 - book of God's remembrance
 - book of our conscience
 - book of life
 - f. Jesus will have plenty collaborating witnesses in this court
 - angels & devil/demons will witness (Zech. 1:11; Rev. 12:10)
 - awakened conscience will witness (Rom. 2:15)
 - dust & rust will witness (Matt. 10:14-15; James 5:3)
 - heaven and earth will witness (Micah 6:2; Deut 30:19)
 - sinners and saints will witness (Luke 11:32; Matt. 12:42)
- C. This day will bring astonishing revelations
 - 1. What appeared *golden* will prove to be *fake* (Matt. 7:23)
 - 2. What appeared worthless will prove to be priceless (Is. 66:2, 5)
- D. Finally the irrevocable and unchangeable sentence will be proclaimed
 - 1. Jesus will welcome His people into His Father's Kingdom: Matt. 25:34
 - 2. Jesus will banish His enemies forever from God's presence: 2 Thess. 1:9; Matt 25:41

Finally: Be warned (Prov. 29:1) and hasten to His still open arms (1 Tim. 1:15; 2:4)
