### Let us Study Philippians (18)

Intro: Phil. 2:5-9: God's portrait of the chiefest of all men.

#### God's Portrait of the Christian

I. Saved II. Indwelled III. Belonging IV. Shining

# I. A Christian is man who is saved

- A. If one is to 'work out your own salvation' that means he possesses salvation
  - 1. This is a truth we are to relish amidst all we find incomplete (1:6)
  - 2. The Spirit's testimony on this point is abundant: Eph. 2:1-8; Romans 8
- B. Make it a prayer point to learn to think about yourself as He speaks about you

### II. A Christian is a man who is indwelled by God

- A. As Christians, we are not a special sort of people able to do the impossible
  - 1. Christians are in some ways still like everyone else (Rom. 7:14-24)
  - 2. But a Christian is a person with *a special indwelling Being*: (vs. 13)
    - a. compare Col. 1:27; Romans 8:10-11; John 14:16-17, 23
- B. God does not dwell within as a Divine Guest but as a Divine Worker
  - 1. God is at work within each of His saints (1:6)
  - 2. Word study of 'working' shows His work is *not in vain* a. compare Eph. 1:11 Eph. 1:20 Col. 1:29 Phi. 3:21
- C. God's work has a specific object: works both to will and to do in you!

D. God's work within has Divine cause: His good pleasure

### **III. Belonging to God's family**

- A. A Christian is privileged to be a son/daughter of God (vs. 15; 2 Cor. 6:18)
- B. We are to savour every aspect of this Divine truth daily in reflection.
  - 1. He is a Father that pities and remembers (Ps. 103)
  - 2. He is a Father Who will never forsake us (Heb. 13:5-6; Is. 49:14-15)

#### IV. Shining as lights in the world

- A. A Christian not only possesses inward (hidden) glories
- B. A Christian also has a public glory: they shine as lights in the world (vs. 15)
  - 1. God's gracious and saving indwelling CANNOT be hidden (Matt. 5:16)
  - 2. What if this 'light' is missing?

# **Closing Reflections**

- A. Thanksgiving is giving thanks to God with our voices: Hebrews 13:15
- B. Thanksgiving is also to use our voice in another way: Phil. 2:16a
