Introduction: We were made for God:

Proverbs 16:4; Isaiah 43:21; Romans 11:36; Hebrews 2:10



I. WE WERE CREATED AND REDEEMED TO BRING PLEASURE TO GOD:

Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and <u>for</u> <u>thy pleasure</u> [for Thy desire] they are and were created. Colossians 1:16 For by him [Christ] were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible,

whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Who pleased God?

Hebrews 11:5 By faith **Enoch** was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, <u>that he pleased God</u>.

The ultimate example of pleasing God, the Father: JESUS CHRIST Matthew 3:17; Matthew 12:18; Matthew 17:5

II. OUR SELFISH NATURE PROPELS US TO SEEK PLEASURE AT ALL COST:

III. FALSE PLEASURE IS FROM SIN:

- 1. Those who live for pleasure are self-centered (all wrapped up in self) Isaiah 47:8a
- 2. Those who live for pleasure will not bear fruit Luke 8:14
- **3.** Those who live for pleasure make <u>pleasure their master</u> and themselves its servants Titus 3:3
- 4. Those who live for pleasure will not love God 2 Timothy 3:4
- 5. Those who live for sin's pleasures will do so only for a <u>short season</u> Hebrews 11:25 True pleasure is from God: Job 36:11; Psalms 16:11

Be a God-pleaser, not a people-pleaser: Galatians 1:10; 1 Thessalonians 2:4

IV. WHAT PLEASES GOD?

The Work of His Son: Jesus Christ: Isaiah 53:10-11

- 1. God is pleased by our adoption as children Psalms 149:4; Ephesians 1:5
- 2. God is pleased by our deep, reverential respect for Him Psalms 147:11
- 3. God is pleased by our spiritual understanding of His plan Ephesians 1:9
- 4. God is pleased by the uprightness of heart 1 Chronicles 29:17
- 5. God is pleased by the <u>public proclamation</u> of His Gospel (preaching pleases God) He is pleased to save men by preaching. 1 Corinthians 1:21
- 6. God is pleased by obedience to parental authority Colossians 3:20
- 7. God is pleased by a practice which matches with our position Colossians 1:10
- 8. God is pleased by our obedience to His Word 1 John 3:22
- 9. God is pleased by every <u>church member fulfilling his/her role in the Body</u> 1 Corinthians 12:18
- **10.** God is pleased by our <u>sacrificial giving</u> Hebrews 13:16

CONCLUSION: "Proving what is <u>acceptable</u> (well-pleasing) unto the Lord" Ask yourself a Question: Is God pleased with my conduct, attitudes, speech, dress, entertainment/amusements, music, TV, my relationships, my present service for Him?
