I. Built upon the principles of God’s Word – 7:24-29

- a. **Hear them** – study the Scripture – 7:24, 28-29
- b. **Do them** – obedience (we will not always do it right) – 7:24
- c. **Success & failure depend on it** – 7:25-27

II. Review of the principles in Proverbs

- a. Avoid trouble at home - Every member of the home saved and obedient to the Lord.
- b. The power of a prudent wife – a godly woman is very influential in the home.
- c. The virtuous woman – a godly woman is the key to the stability of the home.
- d. Wealth, things & the home – contentment & proper management of what God gives us is critical in the home.
- e. Avoiding the house of the wicked – a disobedient member in the home can cause destruction to the entire family. Friends are important.
- f. Wisdom for raising children – Teach, discipline, example, associations.
- g. Protecting the marital relationship – understand the process of sin. Guard your heart & grow your relationship with each other (Contentment, Consideration, Communication, Consecration)
- h. The three pillars of the home – Wisdom – skill, application of knowledge, Understanding –
