## "Man's Created Role Reinforced"

## Genesis 9:1–7

## Big Idea: In connection with the Noahic Covenant, God reinforced man's created role.

- I. Man's Created Role: Its Mandate of Fruitful Dominion (verses 1–4)

  - b. Capital Punishment Commanded by God (verse 6)
    - i. Executed by Human Government
    - ii. Explained by God's Image
  - c. Abundant Procreation Reiterated for Image Bearers (verse 7)

## **Resulting Exhortations**

- 1) Promote human flourishing.
  - a. Multiplied procreation of our race is still our divine mandate.
  - b. Human civilization of the earth is still our divine mandate.
- 2) Recognize human dominion.
  - a. Mankind is God's special creation distinct from the beasts.
  - b. Only idolatry elevates animals or the natural world above mankind.
  - c. Mankind has great responsibilities as lords of the earth.

- 3) Uphold civil government.
  - a. Civil government is primarily God's minister of criminal justice.
  - b. Criminal justice must be administered according to God's law.
  - c. Civil government which redefines its role will answer to a higher king.
    - i. Civil government can abdicate its duty within its jurisdiction.
    - ii. Civil government can usurp authority outside its jurisdiction.
    - iii. Civil governments are and will be judged by the King of kings.
  - d. Christians anticipate a better kingdom ruled by God's righteous King.
    - i. The New Testament Church is the embassy of that kingdom.
    - ii. That kingdom will fully come when its King comes in visible glory.
- 4) Affirm God's good law.
  - a. God's nature and word define right and wrong.
  - b. To redefine morality for ourselves is a high crime of treason.
  - c. Condemned rebels like us have only one hope.
