Westminster Confession of Faith 21.7 (Of Religious Worship, and the Sabbath Day)

As it is the law of nature, that, in general, a due proportion of time be set apart for the worship of God; so, in His Word, by a positive, moral, and perpetual commandment binding all men in all ages, He hath particularly appointed one day in seven, for a Sabbath, to be kept holy unto him:^a which, from the beginning of the world to the resurrection of Christ, was the last day of the week; and, from the resurrection of Christ, was changed into the first day of the week,^b which, in Scripture, is called the Lord's Day,^c and is to be continued to the end of the world, as the Christian Sabbath.^d
