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Habits of humility help
suffering Christians
endure.

HABITS OF HUMILITY

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Exodus 3:19; 6:1; 7:4f; 9:3, 15; 13:3, 9, 14, 16; 15:6; 32:1;
Deuteronomy 4:34; 5:15; 7:8, 19; 9:26; 11:2; 26:8; Joshua 4:24;
Psalm 136:12; Jeremiah 32:21; Daniel 9:15

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↳ The humble will be exalted (Luke 14:11; 18:14).

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↳ Be humble under “God’s mighty hand” (Exodus 13:3ff).

↳ The humble will be exalted (Luke 14:11; 18:14).

↳ So humbly cast your burdens on God (Ps. 55:22).

HABITS OF HUMILITY

1 Peter 5:6–11

1. Humbly throw your anxieties onto God (verses 6–7).
2. Humbly resist Satan's attempts to kill your faith (verses 8–9).
3. Humbly praise the God who reigns. He reigns as long as your suffering lasts, and he'll reign long after it's over (verses 10–11).

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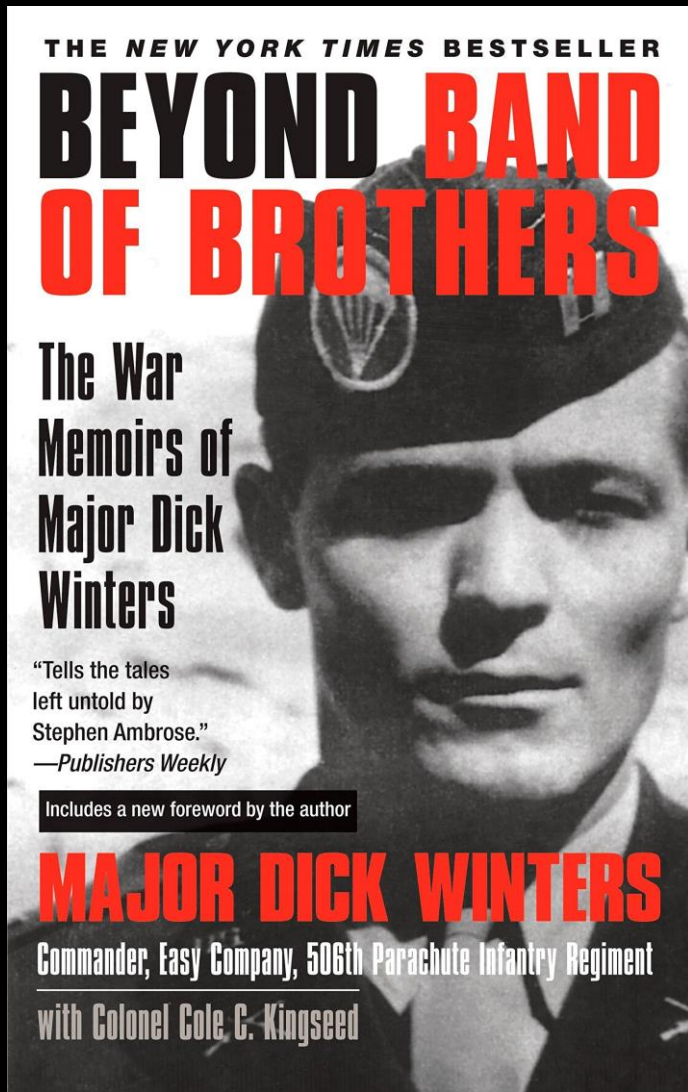
