<sup>4</sup> Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of *any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth: <sup>5</sup> Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; <sup>6</sup> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

<sup>7</sup> Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## QUESTION # 101: WHAT IS THE PREFACE TO THE TEN COMMANDMENTS?

### ANSWER:

THE PREFACE TO THE TEN COMMANDMENTS IS CONTAINED IN THESE WORDS, I AM THE LORD THY GOD, WHICH HAVE BROUGHT THEE OUT OF THE LAND OF EGYPT, OUT OF THE HOUSE OF BONDAGE.<sup>A</sup> WHEREIN GOD MANIFESTETH HIS SOVEREIGNTY, AS BEING JEHOVAH, THE ETERNAL, IMMUTABLE, AND ALMIGHTY GOD;<sup>B</sup> HAVING HIS BEING IN AND OF HIMSELF,<sup>C</sup> AND GIVING BEING TO ALL HIS WORDS<sup>D</sup> AND WORKS;<sup>E</sup> AND THAT HE IS A GOD IN COVENANT, AS WITH ISRAEL OF OLD, SO WITH ALL HIS PEOPLE;<sup>F</sup> WHO, AS HE BROUGHT THEM OUT OF THEIR BONDAGE IN EGYPT, SO HE DELIVERETH US FROM OUR SPIRITUAL THRALDOM;<sup>G</sup> AND THAT THEREFORE WE ARE BOUND TO TAKE HIM FOR OUR GOD ALONE, AND TO KEEP ALL HIS COMMANDMENTS.<sup>H</sup>
