Galatians. 5:1 "Don't let anybody take away your freedom. Stand fast in it." He tells us about some traps to avoid-- three traps. These are the things that will rob you of happiness and joy, and your freedom--- in your Christian life. 1. The Trap of ___ The definition: trying to maintain a perfect performance in order to stay saved. "You foolish Galatians..." "Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes, Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. I'd like to learn one thing. Did you receive the Spirit by observing the law or by believing what you heard? Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort." God doesn't want you to relate to Him out of fear or guilt but out of love. **3;11,** "Clearly no one is justified before God by the law because the righteous will live by faith." 2. The Trap of ______. ---- 4:8 The Definition: when you measure your maturity by how many rules you keep. You measure your spiritual growth; it is the focus on rules instead of relationship. **v. 8** "Formerly, when you didn't know God you were slaves to those who were by nature not gods. But now that you know God, how is it you're turning back to those weak and miserable principles?" "Do you wish to be enslaved by them again? You're observing special days and months and seasons of the year." **Living Bible** says "You're trying to find favor with God by what you do or don't do on certain days or months or seasons of the year." **5:1** "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm then and do not allow yourselves to be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." What is the result of this trap----4:15 "What has happened to all your joy?"
