Gospel of John [The Foot Washing (John 13:1-17)]

-Chs. 13-19 cover a period of less than 24 hours. 33% of John's gospel describe less than one tenth of one percent of Jesus' total public ministry. John focuses on Jesus' final hours with His disciples.

- II. Discourses (chs. 13:31-1633): Comfort
- III. Prayer (ch. 17): Prayer

-v. 1 introduces chapters 13-17. vs. 2, 3 introduce Jesus' washing of the disciples' feet.

Practical Lessons

- 1) Salvation is in Christ alone.
- 2) It's possible to keep company with the people of God and not be washed from your sin.
- 3) It's possible for some of Christ's sincerest followers to be sincerely wrong.
- 4) Believers should rejoice in the spiritual cleansing that comes through faith in Christ.
- 5) We need daily washing.
