A Simple Memo to Sinners

The story of Sodom and Gomorrah is a grievous one. To envision in our minds what Abraham saw first-hand should disturb us because it serves as a vivid example of what unrepentant sin begets. Grievous as it may be the incident gives glory to God. He is righteous in His judgment and He is merciful to deliver.

There is also straightforward four point memo to all sinners in this monumental text.

1. Only God can deliver you from citizenship in the Kingdom of Darkness
2. Staying in your sin will lead to your destruction
3. Set your eyes on the Savior, flee to Him and do not look back!
4. If He delivered you He will take care of you ... don't take things into your own hands!
 - Call out to God – Come out of your sin – Set your eyes on Jesus – Trust the Lord for everything.
