"People Forget; The Lord Remembers!" Zechariah 1:1-6

The things necessary to spiritual restoration.

1. Restoration 'Stalled Out!'

vv. 1-2

- (1) The Lord had not forgotten His People!
 - -1- A Wonderful Beginning: The Return to the Land after 70 years of Captivity!
 - The Decree of Cyrus 538 B.C
 - Zerubbabel, Joshua, and 50,000 others (incl. Zechariah) return 537 B.C. Psalm 126
 - The Temple Altar built, sacrifices offered
 - The Foundation of the Temple laid 536 B.C.
 - No work done 536 520 B.C.

Psalm 85

- -2- But the Restoration had ground to a halt!
 - Spiritual indifference
 - The significance of the Temple and its worship had faded
 - A comparatively unimpressive structure!
- -3- What's in a Name?

"Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo"

- Zechariah a priest and prophet. Ministered w/Haggai. Both "Prophets of the Restoration"
- Returned to the land 18 yrs. previous, as a young man
- Zecharaiah = "the LORD remembers"
 Berechiah = "the Lord blesses"
 Iddo = "timely" or "at the set time"
- (2) A Lesson the Preacher must not forget! "The LORD was very angry with your fathers."
 - The significance of all that went on before:
 - The sins of the previous generations and their refusal to repent This he must preach!
- 2. The Needful Thing: Another 'Return!'

vv. 3-6

- (1) Repentance! A Return to the Lord! "Therefore say to them, (3
 - Thus declares the LORD of hosts:

 They had returned to the land

 "Return to me, says the LORD of hosts, and
 I will return to you, says the LORD of hosts.""
 - The need to turn from their sin and to the Lord
 - The LORD will then return to them! Restoring them! Reviving them! cf. Psalm 85

- (2) Remembrance of the Lesson of the Past
 - -1- "Don't be like your fathers!"

"Do not be like your fathers..."

- Many warnings they forgot! Didn't believe!
- Many sins for which they did not repent!
- -2- Their 'day of opportunity' was long passed!

"Your fathers, where are they?

And the prophets, do they live forever?"

-3- The Word of the LORD stands forever!

"But my words and my statutes...
did they not overtake your fathers?"

- The LORD's word of warning fulfilled. The LORD remembers!
- A 'too late' repentance. Only 'regrets!
- **3. Another Needful Thing: A View to the Future!** (The whole of Zechariah's prophecy)
 - (1) Seeing the true glory of the Temple and its ordinances

What was to be the motive for building?

for build

- The Temple: The great symbol of the true religion
- The great vestibule of God's promise of the future the only hope of the world!
- (2) Seeing the true glory of the church
