One Main Point: As an upright and bona fide ambassador for Christ on their behalf, the Corinthians owe Paul their personal affection.

As One Who Works with God...

- Not receiving the grace of God in vain
 - o The promised time has come—Isa. 49:8
- The finale—one last commendation
 - o Nine sufferings that commend
 - Eight graces that commend
 - o Three spectrums that commend
 - o Seven contrasts that commend
- Open mouths, open hearts
 - o What the Corinthians owe in exchange—widened hearts

In Light of Grace Received...

- Have you "received" God's grace in vain?
 - In what areas do you tend to lapse into claiming God's grace in vain?
- Where do our hearts need to widen toward other Christ-followers?
 - o An honest question: must everyone who is allowed real estate in your heart qualify for their space by abiding by all of your personal terms, conditions and preferences for occupancy?
