"WHO DO YOU TRUST?" ROMANS 8:18-28

- I. THE RESTORATION OF THE BELIEVER IN CHRIST
 - A. God's gifts of reason and revelation
 - Reason operating through the <u>senses</u>: flesh, man's connection to the created world by observation
 - 2. Revelation operating through the <u>spirit</u> by the Spirit, man's connection with His Creator by trusting God
 - 3. Revelation is made to <u>enlighten</u> reason or observation
 - 4. When man died in spirit, revelation was halted, trust was broken and man was left with only his reason to make conclusions about living and relating to God; pride "in his own eyes"
 - 5. Reason alone is inadequate to relate to God and with faith dead, man cannot be justified with God; he is lost or dead to God "give us a king"
 - 6. With the intervention of the spirits of the heavens, man is given an <u>illegal</u> and inappropriate entry into the world of the spirit
 - B. With regeneration, the spirit is made alive and faith is renewed
