Take Heed to How You Hear (Proverbs 8:32-35, miscellaneous texts)

- One of the most important skills we develop is how to listen
- God ordained the parent/child relationship is where we learn to listen
- Proverbs defines wisdom: "fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge"
- Proverbs 8:32-36 personifying wisdom a picture of Christ (1 Cor 1:30)
- Listen, hear x3 times: "listen to me" "hear instruction" "listen to me"

I. How Much Does It Really Matter How We Hear and Listen?

- Prov 1:5 "wise man will hear & increase in learning & man of understanding"
- Prov 1:7 my son, hear the instruction...hear, my children...
- Prov 23:22 Listen to your father who begot you...

II. Why is it So Difficult to Hear and Listen to God?

- Adam & Eve stopped listening to God and started listening to Satan
- Luke 4:16-21 Jesus came to proclaim liberty to the captives
- Rom. 10: 17 "so then faith comes by hearing & hearing by the word of God"

III. What is the Real Danger When We Don't Listen and Hear?

- Prov 8:35 Whoever sins against me sins against his soul & embraces death
- Luke 8:16-18 "Therefore take heed how you hear..."
- Heb 2:1-3 "...we must give heed to the things we heard, lest we drift away"

IV. How Are You Listening Today?

- Prov 8: 32" blessed are those who keep My ways"
- Heb 3: 7-16 "today if you will hear His voice do not harden your hearts"
