Sermon Outline

Exaltation through Humiliation

Hebrews 2:5-13

Jesus, who suffered and died for His brethren will restore humanity's right rule with Christ in glory

Introduction: The blessing of humiliation

Exposition:

- 1. (v. 5) For (gar) the great salvation refers to the world to come
- 2. (v. 6-8a) The crowning of humanity Psalm 8:4-6
- 3. (v. 8b) But not yet
- 4. (v. 9) Jesus, crowned because of His suffering and death
- 5. (v. 10) Jesus brings many sons to glory!
- 6. (v. 11-13) Our union and brotherhood with Christ
 - a. Psalm 22:22 After being delivered from suffering Jesus praises God, with us!
 - b. Isaiah 8:17-18 we benefit from Jesus's implicit trust of His Father.

Application:

- 1. Humiliation and its sources are your spiritual ally, as they break the back of pride.
- 2. Jesus is not ashamed of you, so you must not be ashamed.
