Two Ordinances continued

The Lord's Supper – in Scripture as a memorial of Christ's death (*broken body and shed blood*) and of His return to take His bride home:

- **I Corinthians 11.23-31** –

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Ephesians 3.1-10

(**I Thessalonians 4.16**).

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Hypothetically, let's say it confers grace - Then there is a work to be done for salvation *Ephesians 2:8-9* “**For**

by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: *9* Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

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Romans 11:6 “And if by grace, then [is it] no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if [it be] of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.” Answer Scripture with Scripture

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• What about the teaching of Transubstantiation - The Bible doesn't teach it

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Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put [him] to an open shame.”
